Report of the Trustees for the year ended 31st March 2022

The Trustees present their Report along with the Accounts of the Charity for the year ended 31st March 2022. The Accounts comply with the Charity's Governing Document and with applicable law.

1) Constitution & Objects

The Governing Document is the Constitution adopted on 23rd February, 2020 and registered with the Charity Commission on 25th February, 2020. The Objects of the Charity of Shrewsbury Unitarian Church shall be the promotion of religion in accordance with the principles of the General Assembly of Unitarian and Free Christian Churches.

2) Public Benefit Statement

In pursuit of the Objects of the Trust, the Trustees provide a place of worship for all to attend.

3) Organisation

The names of the Managing Trustees who have served during the year are set out on the front cover of the Report and Accounts.

4) Financial Review

The Total Operating Surplus for the year was £4016.67. The Total Surplus for the year including the revaluation of investments was £45045.73.

5) Risk Management

The Trustees have examined the major strategic, business and operational risks which the Charity faces and confirm that systems have been established to enable regular reports to be produced so that the necessary steps may be taken to lessen these risks.

6) Management & Governance

The Governing Document provides for at least seven Managing Trustees. The Trustees are also empowered to appoint further Trustees offering additional expertise. The Chairman of Trustees is responsible for the induction of any new Trustees including awareness of the duties of a Trustee, and awareness of the Governing Document, administrative procedures, and the historical and philosophical approach of the Charity.

7) Achievement & Performance

During the year, the Trust has continued to pursue the Objectives of the Charity.

8) Reserves

The Trustees have pursued a policy of maintaining the property of the Trust and of supporting the religious and other charitable work of Unitarians in Shrewsbury and in other Unitarian Congregations.

Independent examiner's report to the Trustees of Shrewsbury Unitarian Church

We report to the Trustees on our examination of the accounts of the Shrewsbury Unitarian Church (the Trust) for the year ended 31 March 2022.

Responsibilities and basis of report
