- Keep community up to date on relevant information via Facebook, Text, Instagram, Twitter and the Website. Creating brotherhood by organising trips for kids and parents.

Taraweeh Prayers

- Benefitting the local community by holding Taraweeh prayers at the centre and uploading Taraweeh prayers on YouTube.
- Short reminders during Ramadhan.
- Ease for community with shorter Taraweeh prayers and refreshments.
- We give children the opportunity to lead some Taraweeh prayers to gain confidence and to be future leaders/teachers.

Eid Prayers

- Benefitting the local community with local Eid Salah facilities & fulfilling the Sunnah of praying in open ground.
- We bring together the community as one brotherhood and sisterhood from all different races and cultures and anyone who wants to attend to learn more about us.
