Five new clergy have been recruited who are now all actively engaged in Christian mission and ministry at the local level and across the diocese. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - This has significantly increased our capacity for preaching, teaching, evangelism, and pastoral care. 2. A series of clergy conference days have been held in order to equip the clergy for their ministries and to build the effectiveness of the diocesan team. 3. Financial resources have been dedicated to a new church planting project in York, which is now bearing early fruit in terms of advancing the Christian faith amongst those who would not otherwise have been members of a church. 4. New printed materials have been provided for the St Abdias congregation, in order to make the teachings of the Christian faith accessible to a non-English culture where English is the second language.
