

 2. **Dr. Evans (Bucknell University) – £25,000** contributed towards a study examining **obsessive-compulsive and psychotic-like behaviours across PWS subtypes**. The total project cost was **\$72,984**.
 3. **Rachel Gilmore (Post-Doctoral Fellowship) – £15,000** contributed towards a **three-year research fellowship** studying methods to test for **MAGEL2 gene activity in cells**, in collaboration with **Dr. Schaff in Heidelberg**.

In setting our objective and planning our fundraising activities, our trustees have given serious consideration to the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit.

Achievements and performance

In the 2022 – 2023 financial year FPWR UK contributed to 3 research projects totalling £56,000

Elena Bochukova Dphil at The University of London. A total of £10,000 was contributed - to add to our £60,000 contributed during the 2021/2022 financial year - towards the \$108,000 study looking Genetic Determinants of Behavioural, Physical and Physiological Characteristics of PWS

Dr Giles Yeo of the University of Cambridge. A total of £20,000 was contributed during this financial year. The total cost of this research was \$161,947 and was looking at Mapping the hypothalamic functional architecture underlying appetite control in the PWS brain

£26,000 was contributed to a phase 3 trial into the effectiveness of a device stimulating the Vagus Nerve to control temper outbursts and disruptive behaviour in PWS

Two new staff members were employed on a part time basis, to cover administration and storage and distribution of merchandise.

Financial review

FPWR UK holds in reserve a minimum of £3000 solely for funding future fundraising events, as it does not have any regular ongoing commitments. The sum to be kept in reserve is assessed year on year.

FPWR UK has no funds materially deficit
