B) TO PROMOTE EDUCATION FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE PUBLIC IN STAFFORD, CANNOCK AND ITS ENVIRONS BY RAISING AWARENESS IN MATTERS RELATING TO SEXUAL VIOLENCE AND ITS IMPACT ON INDIVIDUALS AND THE COMMUNITY IN RESPECT OF PSYCHOLOGICAL, SOCIAL, ECONOMIC AND CULTURAL CONSIDERATIONS.
