More widely, the charity organised workshops and performances in local schools and provided free tickets for young people to attend concerts in local venues.</p> <p>The charity provided a free mediation service to neighbours throughout north Devon to help resolve contentious issues between them. In addition to direct requests from members of the public, cases were referred by the Police, Housing Associations and Citizen's Advice. Many involved anti-social behaviour which impacted on the wider community.</p>






