The Trustees present their report along with the financial statements of the charity for the period ended 30th April 2021. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the accounting policies set out and fully comply with the Charity's trust Deed and applicable law.

Structure, Governance and Management

The charity was registered with the charity commission in June 2011. It is governed by a Trust deed.

Objectives and activities

The Charity's objectives are to advance and propagate the knowledge of Islam in the Dewsbury area and the UK. In furtherance of these objectives the mosque is serving as a religious centre as well as providing daily prayers and Friday prayer (Jummah).
