Yorkshire Coast Dog Rescue (Y.C.D.R.) is a registered charity, the object of which is for the benefit of the public and local community by taking in unwanted dogs, providing any necessary medical treatment, and placing them in boarding kennels or foster homes until new homes can be found.

Y.C.D.R. is governed by its 3 trustees and supported by a team of volunteers none of which receive any payment.

The 2024/2025 year proved to be a busy time for us, as more and more people found it necessary to rehome their dog due to a change in home circumstances. We do not have our own kennels, but are very lucky to have the support of a local private boarding kennel, plus a small team of foster homes. As is the policy of our charity, we offer continued financial support to any "golden oldie" dogs which we rehome, as taking on an older dog can incur ongoing vet bills. We are also finding that more dogs than in previous years are presenting with allergies which require on going medication. On occasions we have been approached by the local hospital or social workers when someone has been rushed into hospital leaving a dog home alone, and have placed the pet into a foster home or funded the kennel fees until the owner is back home.

All of our income comes from fund raising events and donations, and was boosted this year by a very generous bequest from Rita Atkinson. We are so grateful to have the continued support of Scarborough Pets at Home Store as their designated charity, and also a newly formed charity shop called Caring 4 Critters. We also appreciate the ongoing fund raising from The Belly Rub and everyone else who donates in any way, as these supporters all help us to continue rescuing and rehoming dogs.
