Objectives and aims

The principal activity of the Charity is to provide health care to the people in the poor region of Pakistan . By following means:-

1. To relieve sickness and the promotion of good health of persons in baltistan, Pakistan ("the beneficial area") in particular but not exclusively in Sermik - Skardu, baltistan.
2. To the advancement of medical treatment and for the relief of disease amongst persons resident or working in the bneficial area.
3. To raise awareness of medical and health issues such as free medical aid camps, surgeries and pharmacies of the benefit of the sick and distressed, cares and their families.
4. To develop mechanism in conjunction with other organisations for the furtherance of the objectives. In the furtherance of these objects the Charity shall be be non-party politics and non-sectarian in religion.

Initially, new trustees work with an existing trustees assisting on particular activities and projects run by the Charity. After satisfactory feed back from existing trustees they are then given the task of leading a particular activity or project, reporting progress at trustee's meetings.

As the charity trustees of the Trust you are responsible for the preparation of the accounts in accordance with the requirements of the Charities Act 2011 ('the Act').




