The Trustees continue to work and abide by the Guidance on Public Benefit by the Charity Commission. We have continued to hold cultural and religious ceremonies, reflecting our growing and diverse community. This includes Yalda Night, Nowruz and over 200 community lunch gatherings, as well as Eid-fitr Prayers, Ramadan dinners, and midnight Mass on Christmas eve. These events are an opportunity for the most vulnerable in our community to gather in a safe, and welcoming environment. We have also continued our fortnightly virtual gatherings. These meetings allow service users to gather, without being physically present in one room, which is perfect for those with physical impairments or those who experience isolation.

## Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

We have continued to work with and educate young people who are 1st generation refugees or descendants of refugees who have fled from their homeland. In many case this upheaval has cause a conflict of identity, as the children struggle to find their place in their culture of origin and the new society they now live in. Additionally, many of these children are from Muslim backgrounds, which in the current social and political climate, adds more pressure on them. We have been successful in organizing seminars and Q&A sessions for these young people, helping give them a safe space to have open dialogue, while also teaching them to embrace British values and way of life, and respecting and acknowledging both cultures which shape them.

We have also assisted victims of domestic violence. Often these women are refugees who have fled across borders to escape abuse, therefore they often lack linguistic skills to access the resources which can help them. We have provided these women with essential information and resources which they can access, as well as where to get legal advice. We provide this information in whichever format is most convenient for these women print, digital, or just verbal.

With around 30 volunteers in our community, we have successfully been able to continue providing essential services to our community to the best of our abilities. This includes befriending phone and video calls with our elderly community members, and paying visits to vulnerable individuals and assisting with daily errands, shopping, and cooking.




