OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objectives and aims

The objectives of the charity are:

(1) "To hold income and capital for the benefit of such exclusively charitable objects and purposes in any part of the world as the trustees may in their discretion think fit and in particular (but without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing) within the area of East Lindsey District Council."

To fulfil the objectives, the trustees may make contributions, as they may think fit, towards, or otherwise assist, any charitable trust, institutions of body having objects similar to those of the charity.

Public benefit reporting

When reviewing the charity's objectives and aims in planning future activities the trustees have considered the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit.

ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE

Charitable activities

The charity continued to make grant payments to other charitable organisations and individuals as deemed appropriate by the trustees.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

The reserves policy of the charity is to maintain unrestricted funds of the charity at a sufficient level which enables the charity to be able to operate.

The results for the year are shown in the receipts and payments accounts on pages 4 and 5. Income was received in the year of £50,000 and grant payments were made by the charity to four separate organisations which totalled £10,000. The total reserves at the end of the year amounted to £73,596.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The governing document is a trust deed dated 15 December 2010.

Organisational structure

The trustees are to hold at least two meetings in every calendar year. The trustees all give freely of their time and expertise without any form of remuneration.

Appointment of new trustees

During the lifetime of the settlors the power of appointing new trustees shall be vested in the settlors or the survivor of them. A new trustee or new trustees may be appointed at any time (either by way of replacement or addition), but so that the total of trustees shall at no time exceed five.
