Summary of the main activities in relation to these objects	We are sponsoring 472 orphans and 33 blind poor people in Bangladesh. We have supported them by transferring to their bank accounts £60 every six months per child to buy his/her food and to continue in his/her education. We made water wells in Madagascar to get clean water in villages

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the financial period

- We have succeeded to pay all orphans without any cash intermediary, but just through the bank.
- 33 poor blind people have benefited from our support by transferring £60 every 6 months to their bank account in Bangladesh.
- We built worship places in poor villages in Tanzania .
- We built Shade structures for kid's schools in Mauritania
- We distributed the meat of 14 cows to poor families during Eid celebration.
- We have made 64 water wells in Madagascar to get clean water in poor villages where there is a need of clean water.
- 472 orphans have benefited from our support by transferring £60 every 6 months to their bank account in Bangladesh.
