CONSTITUTION AND ORGANISATION

The Sarvam Trust is a registered charity, (registered number 1148419). The organisation achieved charitable status on 02 August 2012. Its governing instrument is therefore a charitable trust deed dated 18 June 2012.

The trustees of the charity are:

The charity operates independently to assist Sri Aurobindo Society (India) in village development projects.

OBJECTIVES

The charity's main objective is to further such of the objects of Sri Aurobindo Society (the Indian charity) as are exclusively charitable according to English law, as the trustees shall from time to time in consultation with the Indian charity determine. (The Sri Aurobindo Society is registered in India under the West Bengal Societies Registration Act XXVI OF 1961, and recognised by the government of India as a charitable organisation, a research institute and institution of national importance under the Income Tax Act of 1961).

REVIEW OF THE DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES

During the year the charity continued to assist internationally in village development work in India.

REVIEW OF THE FINANCIAL POSITION

The accounts indicate that the charity had an operating deficit of £14494 for the period on a receipts and payments basis. The charity has no assets other than its two bank accounts, which are utilised solely for the purpose of assisting Sri Aurobindo Society, India. The trustees hope that during the year to end on 30 June 2023 it will be possible to increase and improve on the level of activity seen during the year ended 30 June 2022.

The report was approved by the trustees on 16/05/23 and signed on their behalf.

Independent examiner's statement.


In connection with my examination, no matter has come to my attention: 1. which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect the requirements.
