



Our activities consisted of improving the premises on Haydn Road Nottingham. Unfortunately, due to Covid19 the Punjabi school activities were limited. However, it is envisaged to start the school as soon as practically possible.

A dedicated schools liaison coordinator has been appointed to facilitate greater number of school visits thus creating a greater understanding of the Sikh faith.

Donation were made to number of cultural events promoting unity and harmony between other cultures and faiths.

Donations were made to the Turkey Earthquake fund in March 2023.

To continue to build on the success of previous years a number of religious and cultural programmes were organised. Each request for grant/funds is considered on its merit by the Trustees and funding made available accordingly.

Funds were made available to repatriate a body of young Sikh student at the request of his parents and sibling in India who had died in the UK.


