Activities: The charity seeks to enhance awareness of the role of VAD nurses who gave their lives during both World Wars, and to advance the education of nurses today. Activities include establishing a public memorial (at the National Memorial Arboretum); creating a roll of honour (on the charity's website); educating the public; supporting the education of nurses through individual study grants.
