Structure, governance and management

The charity is governed by its Memorandum of Association dated 4 January 2012. New trustees, who are also directors of the company, are appointed by the existing trustees.

Objects and activities

The object of the charity is the advancement of the Christian religion for the benefit of the general public.

The trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

Achievement and performance

The charity has spent £32,157 during the year (2020 £31,144) in the promoting of the Christian religion in Kenya, including the promotion of Bible teaching, the establishment and maintenance of Churches in Kenya, and the relief of poverty and the welfare needs of its church members. It has also continued with the new project to provide employment and to supply fresh water in Kenya. This project (KEPI) is shown as a restricted fund in the accounts.

Financial Review

The charity's policy is to maintain reserves at a minimum level of £10,000 to cover immediate costs of providing the necessary support for the churches established in Kenya.

Independent Examiner's Report

I report on the accounts of the committee for the year ended 31 January 2021 which are set out on pages 3 to 5.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

The trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. They consider that an audit is not required for the period under section 144 of the Charities Act 2011 (the Charities Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

Basis of independent examiner's statement
