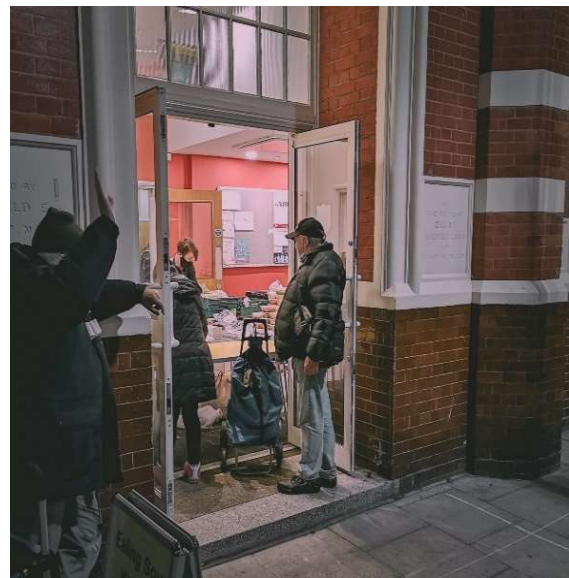

2021 was yet another unusual year with the COVID 19 situation carrying on throughout much of the year with a takeaway only service established in 2020 serving from the doorway of St. John's church in the afternoon at the weekend and the Salvation Army in West Ealing on Monday evenings.



We continued to use a catering firm in Hounslow called Mohan's to supply 100 meals on each day the weekends and along with bananas sourced from a nearby fruit shop plus the bulk buying of bottled water and crisps enabled a straightforward takeaway delivery service for each church team to simply arrive and serve our guests and we soon augmented this with takeaway tea and coffee.

Our amazing volunteers kept the Monday Hub serving home cooked food. We were also able to use Mondays as a distribution point for food parcels supplied by City Harvest and clothes donated by the community. Numbers using the service continued to rise through the covid crisis and remain high.



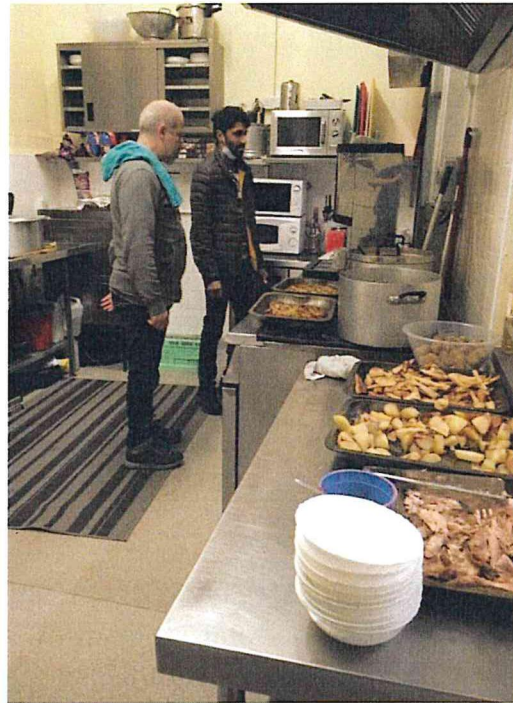
Come the Autumn of 2021 we desired to resume the normal service as soon as possible as our guests need more than food and like many us were missing contact with our fellow human beings and interaction with one another which was evident even with the takeaway service with conversation and our guests staying around to chat. The resumption of normal service with the guests sitting inside has been slower than hoped with guests and teams alike having differing levels of comfort after two years of COVID 19.

It was with sadness to us that the Lord took home Chris one of our long standing guests and soup kitchen hair dresser who also cut hair at Action Homeless concern and who is greatly missed, but now at home with the Lord forever.

In 2020 we were unable to have our normal Christmas day at soup kitchen where we are open all day with an all day Christmas dinner with all the trimmings so it was wonderful to resume this in December 2021 where many would travel from across West London to spend the whole day with food, drink, films and most importantly company throughout the day. One guest commented that Christmas Day at the Ealing Soup Kitchen was his favourite day of the year, which is heartening as Christmas Day is often a hard time of year for our guests.

2020 proved to be a year like no other before for Ealing Soup Kitchen as it has been for many charities during the pandemic with the effect of COVID 19 virus meaning the closure of the normal soup kitchen serving meals and drinks inside the church at St. Johns, which we have done uninterrupted since 1973

However, very quickly the soup kitchen was set-up outside on Mattock Lane with a takeaway service and food sourced from a charity called Peardrop whose cooks were furloughed during the lockdown. With the hot food along with a supply of bottled water and bananas sourced from a local fruit shop and service was resumed. Fortunately, we were also blessed with dry weather from the March to September.



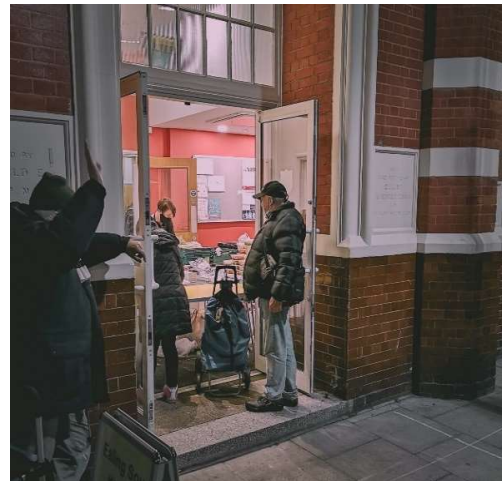

In the September the takeaway service was moved to back door of the church so at least the provisions and those serving would be dry. We also changed caterers to a takeaway restaurant Mohan's in Hounslow. With Mohan's hot food along with fruits, crisps, bottled water and often cake and bread we have continued to provide a value takeaway service to our guests.

Christmas Day was a different affair this year and rather than the normal all day opening and Christmas dinner instead we provided a takeaway service. It was a shame not to entertainment and company throughout the day but at least our Guests were fed and refreshed.

The Friday hub which normally provides clothing and a showering facility had to unfortunately close from the March and had not reopened by the end of the year although clothing was provided where possible during the weekend session although on a smaller scale than usual.

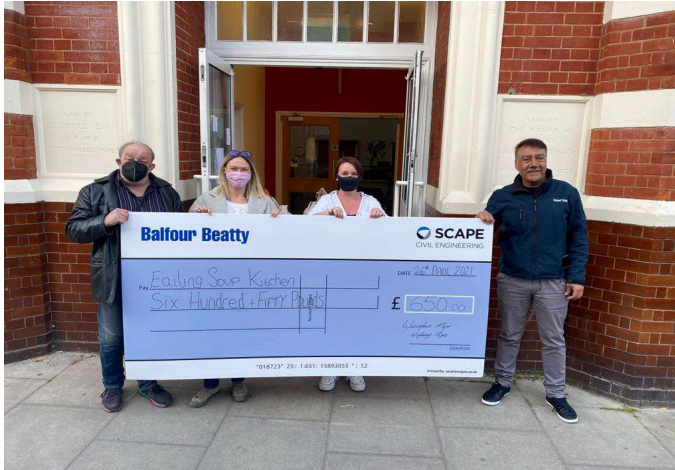
The Monday Hub likewise closed from the March in 2020 and like the weekend soup kitchen offered a takeaway service from the doorway of its usual venue of the Salvation Army in Leeland Road West Ealing. Our amazing team of cooks continued to provide hot meals and our dedicated volunteers served our guests with a takeaway meal and other food items provided by the charity City Harvest.
