Due to bad weather and very bad health of Coaching Centre member the Coaching Centre was not in operation for a significant period during this year.



To encourage children to attend the classes and look after their health, light refreshment is provided during the class break and furthers more a right temperature in study rooms created as per weather.


Due to Corona virus, the Coaching Centre has to be closed. However some financial and clotheing help were provided to students.
