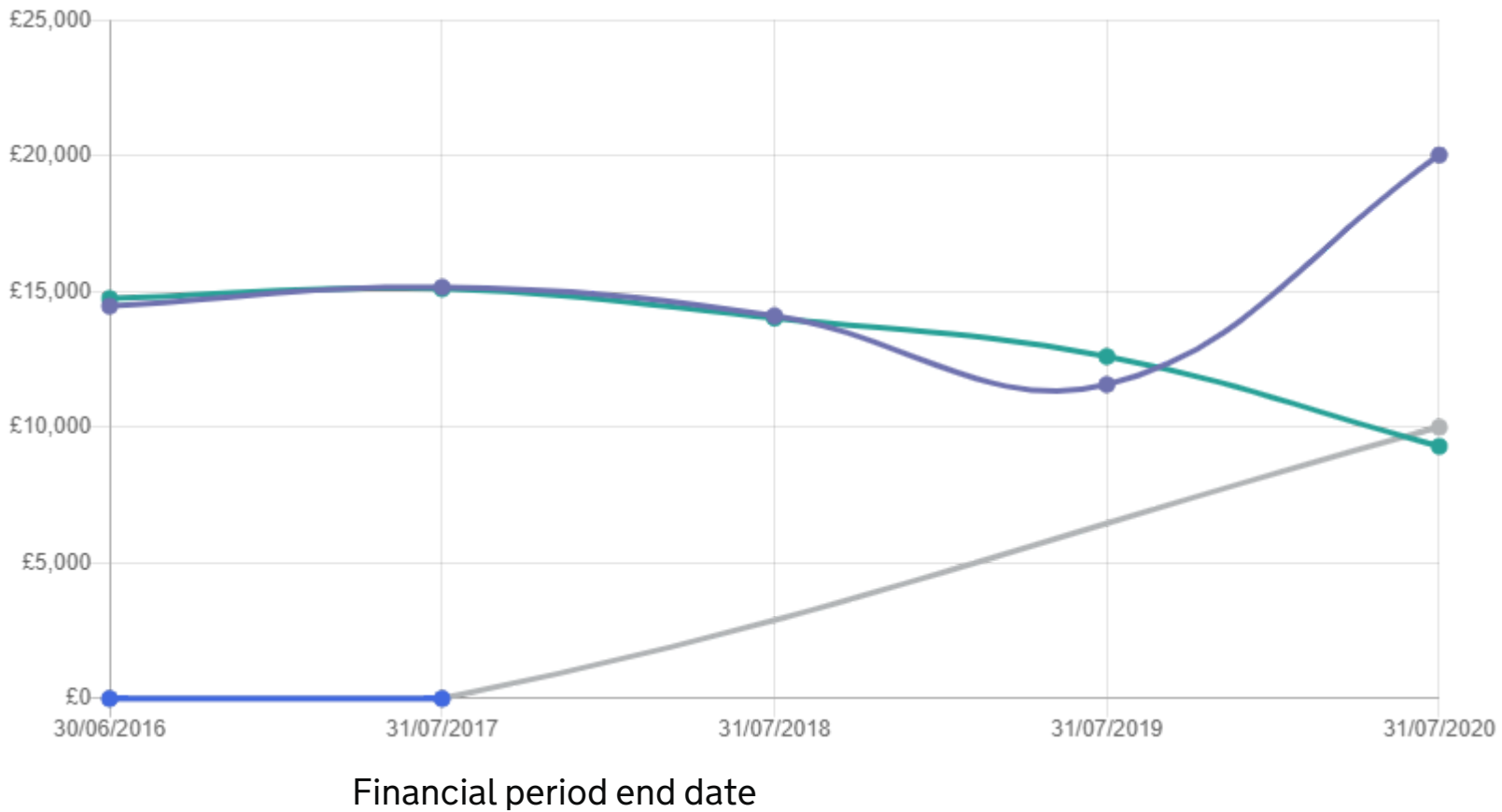
Trustees
