To attend generally to the welfare of all boxer dogs in England in need of care, attention and or rehoming.
 To assist and support members of the community who find themselves unable to meet the needs of their boxer dog.
 To promote kindness to animals, encouraging and educating on responsible pet ownership.
 To suppress and actively discourage cruelty and neglect of animals.
 To establish a series of foster homes, or to provide funding for the use of commercial kennels and training facilities where needed, for stray and unwanted boxer dogs. To provide care for them until they are rehomed or indefinitely when rehoming not possible.
 To co-operate with and establish working arrangements with similar charities or organisations who share the same aims.

The rescue, treatment and rehoming of boxer dogs whose ownership has been relinquished to the charity from owners/keepers in England and Wales, particularly in the North of England.

We have successfully rescued a number of boxer dogs whose owners were no longer able, or no longer willing, to care for them. We have provided necessary veterinary care to most of the dogs and arranged safe, secure and caring homes for them to move to. We have provided help and support to boxer owners in order to prevent their dogs ending up in rescue and post-adoption support to new owners. We make follow-up contact with new owner/s to ensure the placement is successful and that both the dog and new owner/s are happy and safe.


