We did however enable/assist several new programmes with local musicians and we distributed productions made by local film-makers. We have continued to redistribute strong previous programming from some years. This has proven very popular, and helps maintain an interest in the wider community and its social and cultural life. .

The website at www.swindonviewpoint.com has proven very popular indeed, and we have received a great deal of positive feedback. Analytics show that one week scrutinised saw 794 visitors and 1102 videos viewed.

We did however enable/assist several new programmes with local musicians and we distributed productions made by local film-makers. Plus we made a documentary on a local archaeology dig.

Without much new programming we have taken the opportunity to redistribute strong programming from some years back. This has proven very popular, and helps maintain an interest in the wider community and its social and cultural life.

We held a small celebration in September 2023 to mark the 50th anniversary of our Swindon Viewpoint Community Television service.

A small number of archive films were restored, digitised and again made available to the public this year, these included historic footage of the development of the town.

Despite attempts, we did not however succeed in raising sufficient funding to cover equipment or the demands of distribution, nor funding to contract external film-maker / trainers / amateurs to work with local groups and individuals. We therefore were not able to embark on desired initiatives in this area.

No new funds were raised this year, and our balance currently stands at £3254, which is needed for further archive consolidation so unavailable for projects.

Our main source of funding over the past few years has been from DVD sales of the Films '**Railway Town**' and '**Fire and Steel**' and income from this source has been substantial in the past, but is unsurprisingly now tailing off as more and more interested people have already purchased copies, and fewer people these days use DVD. To achieve best results we need to emphasise further funding initiatives.

One thing that remains particularly crucial is to raise the funding to rebuild our website www.swindonviewpoint.com. This is now more than fourteen years old, built on an obsolete platform (Drupal) and no longer functions correctly when it does at all. We are primarily distributing via other platforms at present (e.g. Vimeo and Facebook). One application for funding was made but was unsuccessful. A further funding application to a different source is now planned and partly drafted.

We were able to cover a small number of events which were based outdoors. A number of archive films were restored, digitised and again made available to the public, these included historic footage of the development of the town.

Our main source of funding over the past few years has been from DVD sales of the Films '**Railway Town**' and '**Fire and Steel**' and income from this source has been substantial, but is now very much reduced (as more and more interested people have already purchased them, and fewer people these days use DVD). Hannah Parry served as Chair during this year.

Due to the Coronavirus pandemic the Trustees communicated by electronic means during the year to monitor the operation of the **Swindon Viewpoint** service and advance the aims of Community Media locally.

The pandemic and resulting lockdowns forced us to suspend or heavily reduce our activities during most of this report period. Work with community groups and individuals on issues of importance to them primarily involves social contact, which were either not possible or seen as risky by potential participants as well as ourselves; our activity has therefore focussed more on social media activity. We did however manage to support the Save Swindon Oasis campaign, this was possible because the participants held an outdoor event, which we were safely able to record, including a number of video interviews.

Without much new programming we have taken the opportunity to redistribute programming from some years back via social media. This has proven very popular, and helps maintain an interest in the service as well as the wider community and its social and cultural life. A small number of previously undistributed archive films were restored, digitised and again made available to the public, these included historic footage of the development of the town.

We have not yet succeeded in raising sufficient funding to cover the demands of project coordination and delivery, including for external film-maker/trainers and were therefore not able to embark on desired initiatives in this area.

It remains particularly crucial for Viewpoint to raise funding to rebuild our website www.swindonviewpoint.com. This is now more than fourteen years old, built on an obsolete platform (Drupal) and no longer functions, so we are primarily distributing via other platforms at present (Vimeo, Facebook and Twitter).

Our main source of funding over the past few years has been from DVD sales of the Films '**Railway Town**' and '**Fire and Steel**' and income from this source has been substantial, but as expected this is now tailing off.
