Crossover served every weekend day except for marathon days when roads were closed.

Over the course of the year approximately 1800 bowls of breakfast cereal were served.

Over the course of the year approximately 9000 hot drinks were served.

Over the course of the year approximately 3700 bacon and egg sandwiches were served

Over the course of the year approximately 3000kg of food was received and distributed from Fareshare Sussex to guests.

We increased our outside volunteers to nearly 10 this year.

Crossover served nearly every weekend day missing only missing about 8 weeks due to initial covid lockdowns and Covid self isolation.

Over the course of the year approximately 1800 bowls of breakfast cereal were served.

Over the course of the year approximately 3700 bacon and egg sandwiches were served

Over the course of the year approximately 3000kg of food was received and distributed from Fareshare Sussex to guests.

We increased our outside volunteers by 2 people and lost one this year.




