

THE CHARITY GAVE GRANTS OF £4,500 COMPARED TO £33,055 THE PREVIOUS YEAR. THIS GENERATED A SURPLUS WHICH WAS MAINLY FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE PROJECTS AND THIS WAS ADDED TO THE RESERVES OF THE CHARITY WHICH WERE £105,031 AT YEAR END. THE POLICY OF THE TRUSTEES IS NOT TO HOLD ANY RESERVES BUT TO USE ANY SURPLUS OR RESERVES FOR FUTURE CHARITABLE EXPENDITURE.

THIS GENERATED A SURPLUS WHICH WAS ADDED TO THE RESERVES OF THE CHARITY WHICH WERE 24,524 AT YEAR END. 
