**Structure, governance and management**

The charity is governed by its Constitution and is administered by the trustees, who are responsible for the overall management and strategic direction of the charity. Trustees meet as required to review activities, finances, and future plans.

New trustees are appointed in accordance with the governing document. Trustees give their time voluntarily and receive no remuneration for their services.

**Objectives and Activities**

**Charitable Objects**

The charity is established for the following purposes:

- **To advance the Islamic religion** in accordance with its statement of beliefs; and
- **To relieve financial hardship** among members of the community who are poor and in need.

**Activities During the Period**

During the reporting period, the charity focused on delivering activities aligned with its charitable objectives, funded entirely through donations received from the public.

Key activities included:

- Organising Friday prayer activities in Hammersmith Quakers Meeting House; and
- Organising of breaking the fast during Ramadan.
- Donating to the poor and in need.

The trustees have had due regard to the Charity Commission's public benefit guidance when planning and carrying out the charity's activities.

**Achievements and Performance**

The charity successfully carried out its planned activities during the year, supporting its beneficiaries in line with its objectives. Demand for assistance remained consistent throughout the period, and the charity continued to deploy its resources responsibly to maximise impact.

**Financial Review**

**Income and Expenditure**

For the period ended 6 April 2025:

- **Total donations received:** £59,122
- **Total charity expenses:** £51,322

Expenditure was primarily incurred in delivering charitable activities and supporting the operational needs of the charity.

### **Reserves Policy**

The trustees monitor the charity's reserves to ensure that sufficient funds are available to meet ongoing commitments and future charitable activities. Any surplus funds are retained to support the charity's objectives and maintain financial stability.

### **Going Concern**

After reviewing the charity's financial position and future plans, the trustees believe that the charity has adequate resources to continue its activities for the foreseeable future. Accordingly, the accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis.

### **Plans for Future Periods**

The trustees plan to continue the organisation of weekly Friday prayers and communal iftar during Ramadan, while seeking to modestly expand participation, strengthen volunteer involvement, and ensure the sustainability of the charity's activities through careful financial management and fundraising.

All amounts in these financial statements are presented in UK Pounds Sterling (£), which is the functional and presentation currency of the charity.
