Independent examiner's report to the trustees of Lions Youth Brass

I report on the Accounts of the charity for the Year Ended 31 July 2023 which are set out on pages 1 to 3.

Respective responsibilities of trustee and examiner

The charity's trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The charity's trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under section 43(2) of the Charities Act 1993 and that an independent examination is needed.

The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts and the report is limited to the matters set out in the statement below.

In connection with my examination, no matter has come to my attention:


- 1 which gives me reasonable cause to believe that in any material respect the requirements
