ANNUAL STATEMENT

The year ending March 2024 saw Georgia's Children of the World re-establish the flagship fundraiser G-Festival in June 2023, the event was a huge success in terms of attendance. However, the turnover and effort put in by the committee and an outside promoter didn't really achieve the return we had hoped so it has been decided a Festival on this scale will not be viable in the future.

In October 2023 our original Partners CHOICE CAMBODIA decided they could not afford to fund the school anymore so unfortunately Georgia's House 1 and Carole's classroom, closed in December 2023 along with the rest of the school.

On a much happier note Georgia's Houses 3, 6 & 8 continue to thrive at Oroong Village School in Siem Reap Province under the guidance and management of BFT. We provided funds for a new roof and concrete gate at the entrance to the school, as a new road has been built and the whole village community continues to develop from the humble beginnings a single run down hut 8 years ago. We also continue to assist with teachers' salaries, school supplies, medical supplies and general running costs.

We are now single benefactors to Mr Ross's School in Siem Reap and send regular monthly donations to support the school and maintain Emergency support for extremely poor families in rural Cambodia, with basic food, clothing and medicines under the guidance of our representative Mr Pov Theaross.

The Free School Uniform project with Salford City Council continues but on a much smaller scale as the demand seems to have decreased which has to be a good thing. We also continued to support our partners the Lifecentre in Salford (the home of Georgia's House 5) with the breakfast club and assistance with their holiday hunger program.

We continued to support Love Light Romania with their work at Georgia's House 4, the learning centre in Jacodu Village, which offers early learning and additional support to the Roma community, with many of the children now progressing and thriving in the local state schools.

Some wonderful news came our way in February 2024 when the family of local girl Heidi-Lou, who was born with severe Cerebral Palsy, were finally awarded compensation for Heidi-Lou's condition after the hospital finally admitted full liability following an 11 year battle for justice. Heidi-Lou and her family will now be able to have everything she requires, so they will no longer have to rely on Georgia's Children for support, though our friendship will continue forever!

ANNUAL STATEMENT

The year ending March 2023 has been another very difficult one for Georgia's Children of the World , again we were unable to run our main fund raiser G-Festival as we were unable to find a suitable venue , however in October 2022 we managed to secure a venue for G-Festival in June 2023.

We did manage a couple of decent fund raisers though including the '3peakson2wheels' challenge which involved 4 cyclists climbing the 3 Peaks and cycling the 500 miles between them in 7 days to raise just over £10k for Georgia's Children

On July 23rd we held a smaller G-Festival at The Waterside in Monton to celebrate the 10th Anniversary of our most successful fund raiser, which again raised a little over £10k.

As a result we were able to assist with teachers' salaries, school supplies, medical supplies and general running costs at Oroong Village school to just about keep the school open, but unfortunately we were once again unable to support the kindergarten feeding program as we did prior to the pandemic.

With a self funded trip to Cambodia in May 2022 we managed to visit our partners to catch up with all projects and a timely intervention that actually saved a young baby brought to 'Choice School' very close to death through malnutrition due to lack of money and ill health of the baby's mother.

The Free School Uniform project with Salford City Council continued but again on a much smaller scale this year due to lack of funding. We also continued to support our partners the Lifecentre in Salford (the home of Georgia's House 5) with the breakfast club and assistance with their holiday hunger program.

We continued to support Love Light Romania with their work at Georgia's House 4 , the learning centre in Jacodu Village , which offers early learning and additional support to the Roma community.

We also continued working very closely with family of local girl Heidi- Lou, providing this 9 year old Cerebral Palsy sufferer with regular physiotherapy sessions , an ongoing part of her personal development and mobility skills.

In November 2022 plans got underway for G-Festival 2023 (our first festival in 5 years!) ... Early bird tickets were extremely well received and by the end of March 2023 we had secured some excellent sponsors and raised over £10k in advanced tickets sales with almost 1,000 people attended with 10 weeks to go the big day on June 17th 2023.

We were unfortunately unable to fund the feeding programs, at Oroong School but did manage to assist with teachers' salaries, school supplies, medical supplies and general running costs to just about keep the school open.

We managed to maintain Emergency support for extremely poor families in rural Cambodia, with basic food, clothing and medicines. Our representative Pov Theorsss suffered a serious accident working on of our projects so we assisted in life saving treatment for him.

The Free School Uniform project with Salford City Council continued but again on a much smaller scale this year due to lack of funding. We also continued to support our partners the Lifecentre in Salford (the home of Georgia's House 5) with the breakfast club and assistance with their holiday hunger program.

The year ending March 2021 has been a very difficult one for Georgia's Children of the World , this year we didn't only lose our main fund raising event, G-Festival , we also lost all our other normal fundraising events due to the Covid 19 Pandemic.

We did however manage to pull off a couple of alternative fund raisers to maintain as much of our work as possible, details of which appear later in this report.

Most our projects thankfully still received funding , although often much reduced, from Georgia's Children donations for feeding programs, teachers' salaries, school supplies, medical supplies and general running costs.

Emergency support for extremely poor families in rural Cambodia, with basic food, clothing and medicines, including support with Covid PPE was also maintained, as well as University Education for two gifted youngsters who come from severely underprivileged backgrounds.

We were not in a position to build any further Educational buildings, but instead decided to use some of the funds we had available to complete Georgia's Houses 9 & 10 . These houses are typical Cambodia homes built in a rural community and the start of a 'Homestay' Project where together with our local partner we intend to rent these properties out to tourists, once it is safe to do so again.

All funds raised from the rentals will go to support the local community , with education and basic food supplies , once tourism resumes properly we intend to build further homes to extend what we hope to become a sustainable business for the local community

The Free School Uniform project with Salford City Council continued but surprisingly on a smaller scale to due school closures and council office closures during lockdowns. We also continued to support our partners the Lifecentre in Salford (the home of Georgia's House 5) with the breakfast club when open and food parcels to families instead during lockdown.

We continued working very closely with family of local girl Heidi- Lou, providing this 8 year old Cerebral Palsy sufferer with increased physiotherapy sessions following a serious operation for a double hip replacement.

Fundraising

At the beginning of lockdown it March 2020 , it became very clear if Georgia's Children was to survive the pandemic we would need some alternative fundraising to our usual public events.

So in April 2020 we embarked on our 'Donowt Donate' campaign encouraging people to post videos on Social Media of them doing nothing! ... normally in a comical manner to encourage family and friends to donate to support children in desperate need.

This proved to be quite successful and gave a platform for us to promote 'G-Festival Hits the Streets' on the late Bank Holiday in May 2020. We thought if people can't come to G-Festival , then we would take it to them ! ... Fully social distanced of course !!

So with an army of volunteers, many in fancy dress, we hit the streets! ... taking a mobile sound system on a purpose built trike on a ten mile route through our local area, with thousands of people cheering us on from their doorsteps , donating on line and in buckets on the end of 2m meter poles .

The event was a huge success raising around £15k to make sure we could continue to support the projects we had already started. The event also inspired a close friend of Georgia's Children, Matt Maxwell, to undertake his own personal challenge, which was to run 10k everyday for 100 days starting August right through to December.

We named the event 10k 4 10k , with a target of raising £10,000 ... after a gruelling 3 month's running and a massive social media campaign. Matt completed his one hundred runs , followed immediately by a full Marathon on December 5th, his monumental effort raised a further £12,000.00 .

So despite all the problems of the pandemic and cancellation of ALL our normal fundraising events, together with a few smaller fundraiser activities we managed to raise around £30k to maintain the projects we run in my daughter's name ...
