We maintained ongoing partnerships with selected pounds and shelters, helping to promote dogs in need of homes and providing direct support to assist with their care and successful rehoming.

Monthly newsletters were issued to keep the community informed about the dogs we are supporting, to raise awareness of their individual situations, and to encourage continued fundraising in support of the charity's work.

The funds of the Charity are administered by the Trustees to meet the objectives of the Charity.
The Trustees meet at least bi-annually and maintain regular contact by telephone and email. The Trustees consider that the overall financial position of the Charity is satisfactory, and that the Charity is able to meet its obligations.

The Receipts and Payments Account is set out on the following pages.

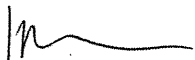
Investments

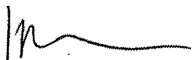
