Introduction

JR reported that 2024 had been another year of Growth for the Trust, with bigger missions this year than in previous years, and opportunities for expansion of the ministry in 2025

JR Finances looked secure with all the overseas missions being fully funded and much of the damage done to the Tree of Life Funds lost in the Subsplash incident be restored

JR Missions and events in the UK were being supported albeit in a small way .

JR We then came to a time of ministry reports Ministry news reports for 2024 which JR mentioned to the trustess could be seen in detail on www.evangelistjulian.com

JR Reported on 5 Missions and training events

JR Report

After a brief introduction Julian gave his report on the years activity working as a CfaN associate evangelist for Enter into Life Ministries, which is part of the work of Global Gathering Christian Community. He spoke about crusades in **Aba Nigeria, Njombe in Zambia, Bidi Bid Refugee camps serving Sudanese refuges in northern Uganda**. Finally, as one of the leaders he trained new evangelists in a **FIRECAMP in London**, and this resulted in an **outreach to the streets of LONDON**

1. City of ABA, NIGERIA – MARCH 3-17th

Julian preached on different nights on 3 simultaneous Aftermath Crusades in the **City of Aba**, Abia State, **Southern Nigeria!!**

- **14,692 Crusade Decisions for Jesus**
- **265,001 Schools & Street Invasion decisions**
- **128,811 Flagship Crusade Decisions!**

JR Personally, Julian was involved with:

- **Crusade preaching at three different locations .**
- **The schools ministries were successful and very fruitful at hundreds of schools.**
- **Street preaching**
- **Conferences and training**
- **The were also church services and a youth crusade.**

MISSION GRAND TOTAL 408,504 Decisions!!

2. City of Ndola Crusade, Zambia May 4th – 26th

JR Personally, Julian was involved with:

- A large team of co Evangelists who completed in total 8 separate full crusades in the Zambian Copperbelt.
- A full 22 Days of Ministry,

281 Outreaches were completed!

In all of these missions, in total, 325,906 heard the gospel,

The total decisions for Jesus for all the crusades, schools and other outreaches were....

MISSION GRAND TOTAL 205,236 Decisions for Jesus!!

3. Masindi Uganda Mission, June 2024

JR We Preached the Gospel to 111, 092 people in schools , prisons, market places and other sites.

- We completed 316 outreaches.

We saw 75,934 people make decisions for Jesus.

- **The Crusade**
 - We had a total attendance over the 5 nights of the crusade of : 50,500.
 - Total decisions for Jesus: 12,938.

Miracles *We saw wonderful miracles which included: a mute and deaf man heard and spoke for the first time, and a woman with a leg paralysed by a bike accident was able to move her leg normally after 4 year!!s*

4. Bidi Bidi Refugee Camp, Uganda Mission, June 2024.

JR reported Total Outreaches, including 5 gospel crusades, 5 women's conferences, 5 Fire conferences, 5 Evangelistic trainings, 36 youth crusades.....

Outreaches 66

Attendance 70,150

Decisions 33,194

JR gave an overview. Bidi Bidi Camp, at a size of 250,000 sq. kilometres, and with a population of a quarter of a million people, is the world second largest refugee resettlement camp on the border between Uganda and Sudan. The people living there are refugees who have escaped the terrible ongoing wars in North and South Sudan, just across the border. It is very poor and supported by the World Food program. Its composition was 80% Muslim, and there were 4 different languages spoken. Before our visit, it had never had an international crusade mission come. But God was going to change all that and powerfully touch these people !

- **JR Breakthrough crusades!!! - The first ever crusade in this camp amongst mainly Sudanese refugees, many Muslim!!**
- **Missions continued on months afterwards with those we trained!**
- **Thousands of new believers actually recorded attending churches after follow up!**

Schools, Outdoors outreaches, including 5 gospel crusades, 5 women's conferences, 5 Fire conferences, 5 Evangelistic trainings, 36 youth crusades...

Total Outreaches 66

Total Attendance 70,150

5. JR - I acted as a coach in Ilford Firecamp in 2024, and completed missions with the students afterward in central London.

JR explained CfaN Fire camp is a powerful and intensive one week training that teaches one on one, street, market place and schools evangelism. It has practical sessions where the students can grow with coaching and encouragement. It also allows those who graduate to become part of the Evangelical Alliance (EA) which means when they graduate, they can join any CfaN teams around the world, and after the additional schools training,

preach in schools worldwide.

JR was asked to be a coach on the team at this one-week CfaN training camp in Ilford UK in June. There were about 90 students. This was followed afterwards by a mission in central London with the students

Mentoring

JR This year GGCC helped fund people train as evangelists with Christ for all nations. This included:

- **Sitalai McLoughlin** – graduated at CfaN School of Evangelism
- **Lori McPherson** - graduated at CfaN Firecamp
- **Leanne Williams** - graduated at CfaN Firecamp

In other projects **JR** reported ...

- **GGCC helped in other projects** such as providing resources to **Pastor Onestah** one of our GGCC supporters, for very fruitful Jesus film nights in Zambia in the Kitwe area
- Sponsoring the training of other individual evangelists in Zambia led by **Evangelist Abuid Nyaende** based in the Copperbelt

Other reports...

HM Report. Harry had given a great contact to Julian this year, a friend who was building a Christian AI program to be used for counselling. His work would fit perfectly in with our plans for the Tree of Life app. He has since been approached by Julian to become part of the team for the Tree of Life Project and the talks and meetings are ongoing.

BS Report. BS Reported he was continuing ministering at the 'Experience Project' a foodbank based in Southend on Sea, and still the largest in the city.

BS reported an example of the many things that had happened in the good work of the project in helping people in a time of economic difficulty, ministry, and described his many regular trips into the surrounding poor estates, places of deprivation and high crime to give out food and the gospel.

Testimonies

We all discussed various and impressive testimonies of events during the year **TESTIMONY JR** shared stories of powerful supernatural healings and dramatic deliverance (all of which can be seen in the www.evangelistjulian.com site) including one unusual deliverance where he had had 18 girls manifest demons all at once at a visit to a primary school, (where one of the children's parents had been shamans/witches and their daughter had led others into witchcraft). After the deliverance, a week later, the two parents of the child who had been encouraging the others into witchcraft came into the head teachers study and gave their life to the Lord!! There were very many testimonies, and we refer to the site mentioned www.evangelisjulian.com where others can be seen in the missions session.

Finances and Funding

JR Introduced financial situation

Tree of life project

- The finances are broadly the same as last year, at around £20,000 (including approx. £4000 when HMRC tax was refunded).

Julian's Evangelistic ministry Enter into Life Ministries

- There was a gift of \$500 from the USA
- A gift came from other donors for Enter into Life Ministries, used entirely to fund flights for missions.
- Other small monthly donations have been received.
- The rest has come from funds supplied by Julian Reddihough

Brent Summers working for The Experience Project

- **BS** Financial gifts were given to him on a regular basis which part funded his evangelistic ministry this year

There were further discussions on an idea to contact famous Christians for funding when the time was right

Tree of Life

This has been largely rested again this year due to **JR** still being fully committed in learning how to direct crusades and still having a big shortfall of funds to execute the project, which is going to need about £100,000 . However, there is still great hope with **HMs** new step forward in A.I work, and we will see how this work progresses . That this would be the way forward for the project when time opened up for more work to be done on it .

Future Developments and Vision

- **Early 2025** In 2025 Julian had plans to be part of the leadership a Jesus Camp training in Nairobi which would be the first part of a fulfilment to the destiny dream he had in 2019 before he joined Cfan. This would be the very first Cfan training event to raise up schools evangelists in Kenya
- **Mid-year** he had plans for a Cfan 'Aftermath' crusade in Congo,
- **Second half of 2025** After this, a full mission in Samfya in Zambia is being planned, including a schools invasion and another Schools mission in the Philippines to Manila and the central Islands.
- **Increase of the mentoring program in 2025** It was thought that the trust could take on more evangelists who could be mentored
- **Plans for a separate GGCC Website** are being discussed for 2025, especially if new evangelists join
- **Other ideas.** Films and media to be made for You Tube subject to time being found .





Ministry news reports for 2023

JR Report After a brief introduction Julian gave his report on the years activity so far working as a CfaN associate evangelist for Enter into Life Ministries, which is part of the work of Global Gathering Christian Community. He spoke about crusades in The Philippines, and summarized and mentioned these points:

There were 5 Missions

APRIL - The Lusaka Zambia Gospel Invasion in N'gombe district.
This was with over 50 other evangelists working in teams.

Personally, I was involved with:

- **Schools preaching.** The schools ministries were successful and very fruitful at hundreds of schools.
- **We also preached to prisoners at a police station** – most of the prisoners indicated decisions for Jesus.
- **In a hospital waiting area,** with a large number of people responding.
- **The largest street outreach was at a large woodyard cutting and preparing lumber** , with hundreds of workers attending and making a response.
- **The were also church services and a youth crusade.**
- **Street preaching** - The most amazing healing happened to a deaf child in a deserted neighbourhood square with just a small number of children playing. We preached to them. The deaf child received his hearing back, and we were testing this, and this caused such an impact as he was know in the community that the whole square filled up with people. 175 people accepts Jesus because of this healing.

In total the number of recorded decisions for Jesus over the 3 weeks was 209,133

MAY - Crusade Mission - Kalulushi in Zambia

This is a town in the Zambian Copperbelt, with around approx. 100,000 inhabitants. I was a leader in one of two teams that did the very first two CfaN Aftermath 'spinoff' crusades, held after the main Cfan Decapolis crusades had finished.

- **I was one of only 3 Bootcamp evangelists in this crusade preach on the mainstage**

Amazing healings happened

- Women who lost her sense of smell, was healed and it returned during the prayer
- I man who had blindness caused by diabetes was healed and tested on stage
- A man with a broken leg was healed he could move normally, and his pain had gone after prayer

- A woman with tremendous swelling from Fibroids said during the prayer the swelling and pain completely disappeared.
- A man who said he had needed a stick to walk for 18 years was able to walk and run, dance and move on stage after being healed during the prayer. He left his stick on the stage

In total the number of recorded decisions for Jesus was 38,957

- An evangelistic association called **Kalulushi 4 Jesus!** with its own web page started after the mission, and continues to do evangelistic events afterwards.

JULY Crusade Mission - Migori in Kenya

A crusade conducted in the midst of riots!

This crusade had a successful schools mission in the first week. But JR explained the main crusade was affected by a public day of protest scheduled on the same day, which turned into a riot with gunfire and a person getting killed. This protest was due to the government raising new taxes on maize and basic foodstuffs. So our first day of the crusade had to be cancelled. The police advised us to stay inside the hotel

We also had to move the crusade to another location (not shown on our publicity) because of other protests about the use of our venue which unknown to us others wanted to use on one of the nights

Nevertheless, with the school, crusades and other outreaches the four main evangelists and **teams saw over 32,000 recorded decisions for Jesus.** We thank Jesus for his faithfulness even during a time of adversity

JR reported that the full reports for all of these missions have been updated in the ministry site www.enterinto.life (or www.evangelistjulian.com)

OCTOBER – Lake Constance Germany (at the German Austrian border) CfaN School of Evangelism (SOE)

I was asked to be a coach at for the two weeks of initiation for the students of the CfaN school of Evangelism in Germany. **During this time,**

I coached different groups of students and assessed their preaching prior to their graduation

- Many were saved during street outreaches in various towns along the banks of lake Constance
- The SOE finished with a big crusade '**Nights of Hope**' which saw over 170 decisions for Jesus

DECEMBER – General Santos Schools Missions – The Philippines

A schools crusade mission with an earthquake!!

JR explained: Quite literally there was an earthquake in Davao where we had planned to do schools evangelism when we arrived, and the schools were all closed until they had been inspected for safety after an earthquake. So, unable to do the schools in the city of Davao we moved to the city of General Santos right on the southern tip of the Philippines.

But there was a **spiritual earthquake** in that city, which happened during the three weeks. I attended for 2 weeks, and there was a large team of about 20 evangelists with me.

In that three weeks there were

- 212 Outreaches
- 130,198 in attendance
- **91,746 Decisions for Jesus in the schools and street outreaches**

HM Report Harry reported that he was working as a University Lecturer, and as a software consultant. He had been poached by a company called ICIAN at the end of 2023 and was doing commercial research. He said the goals of collaboration with ICIAN was to build thinker for the Tree of Life, either by a collaboration or by getting the skills to be able to do it himself

He gave testimonies:

HM explained how he supports and attends the ministry at Moggerhanger where meetings of Christians involved in Kingdom technology projects and online related activities are held, started by a man called Ravi, who in the 1980s had a vision of Jesus (*note: Moggerhanger House is run by a charity*

with the aims of advancing the Christian religion). He gave a story of Georgia a woman who attended Moggerhanger. He explained how she had left the New Age and had come into full time Christian service.

BS, JR and HM discussed the potential of this Christian investment and tech event, emphasizing the need for developing relationships for investment opportunities and creative people to work on the Tree of Life app.

HM said that indeed at the 2023 event someone had discussed possibly giving £250,000 to GGCC, which even although this didn't happen, it showed the potential of the event.

BS Report Working at the 'Experience Project' a foodbank based in Southend on Sea, and still the largest in the city.

BS reported an example of the many things that had happened in the good work of the project in helping people in a time of economic difficulty, ministry which he described as '*Christian guerilla warfare*', as there were many sorties into the surrounding poor estates, places of deprivation and high crime to give out food and the gospel.

Testimonies he shared were

A volunteer at the project diagnosed with cancer, who was prayed for. But when he came to his operation, the doctors couldn't find the cancer. His heart problem had also got better.

They had seen salvations too. There was another lady who had a cancer diagnosis and was completely healed too. Her son asked if he could be prayed for. Now they both go to church

Discussions

We all discussed various testimonies of events during the year where God had given us supernatural dreams and divine appointments and opportunities for us to be able to share the gospel with others and see God move in a supernatural way to reveal his word to people.

JR shared two stories where he had been supernaturally led to people, one at the Royal Albert Hall, sitting next to a shaman, who he had previously met at a party 4 years earlier, (leading to an invite for a meeting where he heard

the gospel) and the other one on a plane in the Philippines where her daughter lived very close to JR in Westcliff





Ministry news reports and developments

JR Report Julian gave his report on the years activity so far working as a CfaN associate evangelist for Enter into Life Ministries, which is

part of the work of Global Gathering Christian Community. He spoke about crusades in Tanzania (two crusades) Pakistan, and Uganda in the past year;

4 crusades

- **Makambako Tanzania 28,000 decisions for Christ**
- **Njombe Tanzania 24,000 decisions** Both these crusades, held in the same month had crowds of between 5-7 thousand people. The schools ministries were successful and very fruitful.
- **Gujranwala Lahore / and a district of Karachi Pakistan crusades** These 2-day crusades saw many salvations and miraculous healings, with crowds exceeding 8,000 and over 2,000 decisions for Christ (many more but they could not be recorded for the CfaN Decade of Double harvest total, as the follow up books ran out!). The owner of the crusade grown in Lahore tried to cancel the meeting at the last minute, but he didn't prevail, nor did the huge rainstorm before the meeting stop the crowds or the crusade. There were many healings. JR had a word of knowledge for a woman with a chronic throat problem, and she immediate came forward and was healed. Queues of people came forward who had been in pain or had restricted movement to testify how the lord had healed them !!
- **Kitgum Uganda - 42,497 decisions for Christ.** There was a huge number of salvations, healings with a dozen demons manifesting in the crusade every night. 5 witches gave their lives to Jesus (one publicly on stage before the crowds). The crowds were between 5,000 to 8,000. The main crusades had 4,492 decisions for Jesus. We also had breakthroughs against opposition with the schools, where we had an initial setback. Julian explained the trouble there had been with the opposition of the Scripture union representative to Cfans school plan, and an issue with the education authority. Nevertheless, we managed to preach in 113 schools with a total of 34,052

decisions for Jesus. The city had been the centre of an area run by terrorists war lord only 10-15 years previously, and was on the border of Sudan, which had a civil conflict. This contributed to the demonic atmosphere of the place, but we believe we had made a breakthrough. We had enormous success in the Palabek refugee resettlement camps filled with Sudanese refugees from this conflict, with 3 pop up crusades with thousands coming and a large proportion giving their lives to Christ – around 3,053!

Julian reported that the full reports for all of these missions have been updated in the ministry site www.enterinto.life (or www.evangelistjulian.com)

Prayer partners for GGCC and Enter into Life Ministries

We had a great prayer meetings on zoom, and an encouraging growth of support for the ministry. This prayer released real power which was evident especially in the Uganda crusade where real breakthroughs were made.

Supporters and ministry followers

A growing with a large number on Face book responding in interest exceeding many thousand

HM Report Harry started by announcing he was now a University AI consultant. He has started a human centred AI company. All working to facilitate and develop his new software ‘Thinker’ and reaching out to Christian Jews

- He is presently living in Birmingham where he is developing the skills and network for the GGCC Tree of life project in development.

He introduced the group to Andy who had similar ideas to us and was producing his own website. (J R contacted him).

BS Report Working at the ‘Experience Project’ a foodbank based in Southend on Sea, and now the largest in the city.

- The project has grown exponentially reaching thousands every month
- But not as Simon, the project leader expected
- It has dropped its mandate to help children specifically and is now just a foodbank
- It now has 12 volunteers

Brent reported an example of the many things that had happened in the good work of the project in helping people in a time of economic difficulty

‘There was a phone call from someone with health issues, who we had been helping with food parcels for 2 years... he had been suicidal. I prayed for him, and he gave his life to the Lord. I know God has called us to be fishers of men...but this was like a fish jumping into the boat!!’

Discussions

BS asked HM if using A.I. gets us drawn into something that would be a moral compromise

HM replied Of course in the market place are things like pornography, we don’t want to be part of that. But my company Human A.I. increases A.I. for improving the wellbeing for everyone. The heart of what I trying to do is give tools that increase the ability to make good choices in life. A.I is making everyone more powerful

HM showed us the Christian A.I. site and especially highlighted a chat Christian A.I. site which you can ask any question.

JR said This is the way to go for the Tree of Life

BS said ‘But can we trust this??. It’s a big deal if something that the A.I comes up with is “off” ‘

HM said my friend built it. We need to ask these sort of questions to him. There is a lot of synergy between us and him.

JR said we should look at this and check it

HM mentioned that having a meeting would be a great move

JR said I am free in July August. Let have a meet up if he is in Essex

My experience with questioning Chat gpt is that it didn't explain properly the need for repentance in coming to God

HM I can check to see if we can fix those issues

BS this thing could be a good supplementary, but it is not as good as a one on one

HM Lets meet in August

The discussions then turned to the project Brent is working for, and the issues with the leader of the project

JR We must pray for Simon concerning his beliefs and his change from Christianity. We need to pray that someone takes over the project with a Christian perspective if nothing changes.

Julian mentioned that kids potential at Wittingham (where the project is being run) is huge. Also, the phone line there can be better than 111 or 999 for some people.

He also warned about Simons false believes in Universalism

BS He has a belief that Jesus birth is more important than his death. It has affected his gifting

Brent then mentioned that he would value people prayers for his financial situation which he felt were under attack

Finances and Funding

JR Showed the financial situation from the statements The finances are broadly the same as last year, as the inflow of money for the crusades was the same as the outflow and there had been no large donations for the Tree of Life

- Had an idea to contact famous Christians for funding

- Susan Boyle
- Tyson Fury

But maybe to wait 6 months to a year until some more crusades added to the CV of GGCC.

Subsplash issue. This was concerning. There still had been no resolution and Subsplash would not budge on giving any refunds for work they never did for the Charity. JR said this needed him to set aside some time to have another go with higher up bosses, but it didn't look encouraging as they were completely intransigent

For the record GGCC has been supporting the work of The Experience Project in Southend although this is under review due to its leadership

Tree of Life

This had been largely rested this year due to JR being fully committed in learning how to direct crusades. However, there were great hope with HM new step forward in A.I. that this would be the way forward for the project when time opened up for more work to be done on it

Future developments

JR announce that he had begun to write an evangelistic testimony book, and was drafting this out with evangelist Lori McPherson who was helping him write it

Next year 2023 JR had plans to visit Zambia for the CfaN Gospel Invasion in the spring, and to do a crusade in Kenya TBA

Any other business

There was none.


Prayer

The meeting was held on the second Saturday of the month

Opening Prayers

JR led an opening prayer.

1. Financials/fundraising

- **JR** We currently have approx. £25,000 available for the project if a forthcoming rebate for gift aid is taken into account, and an outstanding amount from the Avenue Trust.
- **JR** has finally received all the instruction from the accountant to make the HMRC reclaim of income tax from the donation in question
- **JR** Outgoings, other than maintenance costs for websites etc included two payments to Harry Moyse of £1500 and £500 for the continued development of Thinker. This was in payment for 1 month's work for GGCC.
- It also included a payment for the Promotional website update to the US company Sub Splash, of £873.51 although this hasn't started yet.
- **JR HM BS** It is noted that none of us have yet been able to load up the content for Sub splash as there is still work to be done on it.
- **JR** We have some new donors for the crusade ministry through the *Enter into Life site* and a new bank account has been opened to specifically take donations for this side of the trusts work

The accounts are up to date and have been completed by Mann and Co and a return to the charity commission.

2. Trustees' roles

- These are the same as last year, but **HM** has also been collecting testimonies as well as developing **Thinker** and he will be sharing with **BS** so that a combined list can be harmonized. A discussion of various new suitable testimonies with evidence obtained was had between **BS, HM and JR**
- **JR** Enter into Life Ministries (Evangelist Julian) This functions as fully part of GGCC as is the Evangelistic crusade side of GGCC activities,

Other roles:

- **BS** 'The Experience Project' in Southend
- **HM** An ex JW disciple group. Extreme Bible study group

3. GGCC Activities and new developments (Separate from Tree of Life)

JR Africa Report

JR summarized at the meeting what he had been doing on GGCC missions to Africa. He reported that 2021 had been a fantastic year GGCC with the crusade ministry in Africa (and all the updates can be separately seen in detail [on the new GGCC evangelism crusades website www.enterinto.life](http://www.enterinto.life))

This included:

- **A 3-week CfaN coaching initiation trip** for JR as a completion of his Boot camp training, which was comprised of school's evangelism and pop-up truck and market crusades in teams in the city of Morogoro, Tanzania.
- **JR then did a 2000 Km scouting trip** across central Tanzania identifying and preparing the ground with a crusade director for **7 crusades** in 7 towns/ small cities
- **5 of these towns were crusaded**, with main crusades, meetings, fire conferences. schools' evangelism and pop-up crusades in markets and other public areas. Much of the ministry utilized evangelistic trucks and

teams. **The result was over 76,000 recorded decisions for Christ (including schools figures)**

- **JR was involved with 3 other evangelists in a EAC crusade in Kilosa** (as one of the above 5 crusades) with the same format. **There they saw over 18,000 decisions for Christ over a 2-week period**
- **JR also did a kids crusade in the city of Morogoro with another evangelistic organisation**, and a Evangelism Invasion crusade in Dar es Salaam with other CfaN evangelists where the teams saw many thousands make decisions for Christ, which also included church preaching and schools and pop up crusades
- **He went and did a televised discipleship conference, and preaching in Kenya** for Dr Bishop Charles Marita and Tumaini TV in Nakuru in Kenya (Tumaini TV now has a potential audience/coverage of 7.5 million people in the Nakuru and Nairobi areas of Kenya)

On all these events and activities, **JR reported that the Lord power was seen in many miraculous healings**, which are logged on our GGCC website. www.enterinto.life

JR, HM and **BS** all gave thanks to God for all that he had done and for his tremendous answered prayers and for the souls save, and gave him all the glory!!!

Plans for 2022

- JR announced has active plans to go to do crusades in Zambia, Tanzania and Uganda in the coming year, and is currently in discussions about these outreaches

4.Tree of Life progress report

There had been some delays again this year to progress caused by

- The large period of time **JR** was away in Africa, on missions
- **BS** involved in a build-up of intensive work for the Experience Project after the ending of the covid lockdown
- HM getting married and working in a new job.

We reaffirmed the aims and scope of Tree of Life;

- Preaching Gospel Messages.
- An Interactive/community.
- Apologetic The Bible – A book that is Extraordinary, History, Prophecy, Mystery. Answering specific common objections.
- Healing Testimonies/ Miracle evidence.

JR noted that due to the development of a CfaN ap this year for its evangelists, the ideas of a resource for evangelistic events in different evangelists locality – section and resource for evangelists on the Tree of Life would be scaled back .

HM and BS The gathering of testimonies with evidence is making good progress

JR Tree of Life remains on the CfaN graduate program - The Online Evangelist Tree of Life Initiative. (10 graduates expressed interest)

JR Content material for the Tree of Life website /ap continues to grow.

HM agreed to make a Google Drive for content to be loaded up in preparation for the site construction.

JR After a couple of failed attempts with designers this year JR invited the meeting to consider **some different conceptual ideas for a graphic** to develop for the look of the Promotional site, so no more time would be wasted

The current website picture;



HM BS JR discussed this and although it had the merit of a symmetrical shape, the mirrored look did make faces in the picture which even with attempts at disguising by a graphic designer still seem to show ‘faces’ which look evil!

Other potential replacements:

No 1. Many trees by water (representing river of life)



No 2. Single tree with light shining through it by water



3. Broad leaf tree with light shing through



4. A stylised graphic image of a tree rather than basing it on a picture of a real one



JR HM BS Had discussion on these graphics, and it was noted that JR and HM expressed a preference for a revised version of no 3

HM mentioned that no 3 could be photoshopped to make it more symmetrical and perfect looking

JR said that moving lighting effects could be added to this as we originally discussed or it can be animated like <https://vimeo.com/46806453>

JR then raised the subject of changes to the promotional website text and other factors, and a discussion with **BS** and **HM** agreed with a target finishing date for these changes in the summer of 2022

5. Harry's Thinker/Tree of Life work update

HM discussed the stage that the thinker development was at which he described as proof of concept or 'bicycle' stage. As such, it had some functionality, but more development was required to get it to the 'motor' car stage which is the full realisation of the vision for the software.

HM mentioned that he had a way of using some of the software in a simpler form which could have a commercial application to be sold at universities and other organisations such as business schools. He then went into some detail with **BS** and **JR** with illustrations of how this software could work to sort out arguments from counter arguments so people could see the roots of their disagreements not the superficial emotional aspects. This would bring clarity of thought on the matter in question. This he said could have some financial blessing for GGCC in the form of a tithe of the profits.

6. Brents Testimonies /Tree of Life work update/ The Experience Project outreach

BS explained how he was discovering new testimonies with evidence, and how they would be presentable on the website and app. He has developed categories, according to the supernatural gift of God shown, such as word of knowledge, healing, word of wisdom

The Experience Project

BS is working in this project with the support of **HM** and **JR** as part of GGCC aims of evangelism

BS mentioned that he had seen around half a dozen salvations in the past year at the experience project, and people healed, and we all praised God and gave glory to God for everything he is doing

There were discussions between **BS, JR** and **HM** about Simons current position before God and his leadership goals of the project, which it was noted at this current point frustrate potential ministry that as a group GGCC could have a

further role in. Currently the leadership presented a block on what we could do, and for a church plant. We all agreed the situation needed prayer for things to change.

7. Any new Potential developers

HM suggested a new developer for the main development. His name is David White. He is a Christian with his own established business and track record. He is a full stack guy, so his gifts include design. He does artificial intelligence. His site is called www.netriver.com

8. Any other Business/ideas





Opening Prayers

Harry opened in Prayer

1. Financials

JR We currently have approx. £28,500 in the account, similar to last year, if a forthcoming rebate for gift aid is taken into account, and an outstanding amount from the Avenue Trust.

JR Outgoings continue to be modest, just the continuing costs maintaining the domain name treeof.life and thetreeof.life and themeaningandpurposeof.life

2. Staff appointments/ Trustees' roles

JR Remains working on the project compiling apologetics under different topic headings when free from Enter into Life Work, that will answer questions and objections about Christianity.

BS Is presently working for us one and a half days a week compiling testimonies.

HM since the last trustees meeting, has been doing consultancy work, which has given him a lot of time to focus on GGCC projects. He has written a large amount of documentation for the tree of life app, as well as working with John Lewis to design its architecture. Additionally, using the discord using the Discord API has prototyped

and tested some of its unique features, and is preparing to conduct multi-user tests.

This has all been done without charge.

Due to changing family circumstances and a full-time job offer, may have to dramatically reduce the amount of time he puts into GGCC projects.

He explained; 'I have been offered a full time normal job, which is finite element modelling, for structures, or for example for vehicles that you might crash'.

JR what do you need financially if you worked full time for GGCC instead of taking this other job?

HM This is a conflict of interests. Speaking, then, not as a trustee but a contractor who believes in our work, I would be happy to half my normal salary, and take 18 K for 20 hours a week for 12 months.

Currently we have a demo version which is ready for multi-user tests. As we conduct these tests, we could build a community around it. This would help us validate everything we are developing, and make sure that it works well with people before we start investing money into an app.

This would also be hugely useful for funders. Over a year I would expect to grow its users base from 10 or so to thousands of people – and see hopefully close to a million interactions in total.

It will show faithfulness to the trusts we seek funding from, so they see its not just an idea but actually functional.

We have a great vision, but at the moment we cannot show we have executed the vision.

I feel this is very much in our grasp, not many hurdles as there were before.

JR new legislation must be considered concerning Trustees and benefits/payments, I will check, but we all must.

HM We can have a conversation with Matt Jermyn my housemate who is an expert on this.

3. GGCC Activities and new developments

JR gave a summary

JR I have this year graduated and been ordained as a Minister of the Gospel after attending the CfaN Bootcamp school run by Daniel Kolenda and Peter Vandenberg. This will enable me to begin a Crusade ministry, which will include, large and smaller Crusades, town outreaches, schools' missions, and conferences and other church events and meetings.

JR This require the formation of a new ministry to be called Enter into Life Ministries which with the agreement of the trustees will be part of the GGCC charity. This could be something that **HM** and **BS** could have involvement in, in the future. Currently **JR** is in discussions to plan crusades and missions for 2021.

JR I have at my own expense procured the name **enterinto.life** for the ministry, and I think this name fits well with **treeof.life** . I will be able to advertise 'The Tree of Life' whilst doing 'Enter into Life' evangelistic work – the two will work together well.

Both **BS** and **HM** agreed that **Enter into Life** could be part of GGCC as a new ministry.

JR However, I propose the finances for 'Enter into Life' will be kept completely separate from the 'Tree of Life' and any other separate GGCC projects. This will require an additional bank account to be opened at some stage for designated donations. A fully functional ministry site for **enterinto.life** is near to completion. **JR** has so far paid all expenses for Enter into Life out of his own pocket until funding for this ministry is underway. **JR** states that Tree of Life retains the priority for funding, and doesn't see a conflict of interest as both ministries will appeal to different audiences.

BS – Is now working in **cooperation with Simon in his new work in Whittingham Avenue estate**, 'The Experience Project' in Southend, in an area of deprivation, where the church had been previously closed. 'Tree of Life' and 'Enter into Life' could possibly be incorporated into this ministry in future.

JR Options remain open of working with team of Chaplains in Southend, with the idea of a *Spirit Café* along the high street being called 'The Tree of Life'. But

this has been on hold all this year due to Julian being at CfaN and until the Covid restrictions are over.

4. Tree of Life progress report

JR I have this year Graduated and been ordained as a Minister of the Gospel at the CfaN Bootcamp school run by Daniel Kolenda and Peter Vandenberg This has opened up unprecedented new opportunities for GGCC and specifically the Tree of Life, that we could not have foreseen even a year ago. **It has however lead to a reappraisal of the aims of the Tree of Life Project**, and together with me being away has led to some delay of the progress we would have made if we had continued on the path envisaged at the last trustees meeting (Julian's acceptance and approval on the Bootcamp had not been approved at that time) However the net gains far outweigh this.

More ideas of the Aims and scope of Tree of Life

JR For the record, considering developments with me attending CfaN, in order that it can become a CfaN approved initiative, I proposed that we the trustees agreed to change the scope of the app to make it a true Online Evangelist app with 5 Inputs on the Home page, and it was agreed:

- Preaching Gospel Messages.
- Interactive/community.
- Apologetic/ answering objections.
- Healing Testimonies/ Miracle evidence.
- Evangelistic events in the user's locality – section and resource for evangelists.

Tree of Life progress report (cont'd)

JR We have now become a CfaN graduate program called The Online Evangelist Tree of Life Initiative. Other Graduates interested/in the team are:

- Laura Clayton, who is based in Orlando with access to CfaN.
- Tyrelle Smith, a Christian author in Canada.

And 8 other graduates, who have expressed interest and/or offered specific help. We are attending regular CfaN student Initiative updates online.

JR We have a temporary promotional website linked in to thetreeof.life and now treeof.life which we are grateful for Brent for his work But we have all agreed that it needs to be upgraded by paying a professional developer to enhance it to appeal to big donors.

JR CfaN has offered its database of testimonies. This offer will be accessed this year and JR is discussing how this will happen with BS, and accessing doctor evidence compiled by African Crusade Director John Darku, who has worked virtually from the beginning with Reinhard Bonnke and who Julian met at the 2020 CfaN planning meeting whilst at Bootcamp.

JR A specific promotional film for The Tree of Life has been asked for from Daniel Kolenda, but as of yet we are waiting for this. In the meantime, we do have one which has been made by Daniel Kolenda for all graduates, which we are authorized to use, and this could be completely adequate. It supports JR and will add a big name to our supporters.

About 80 Trusts have been identified by BS that we will approach We agree that we will not do this until the new site is ready, as it will be part of our presentation to future donors and supporters.

BS and **JR** agree we can prioritize this list.

HM This is professional fundraiser way to do it.

JR We have previously all agreed that we should look at a plan to be made for this promotional site by Rodolfo, who made Daniel Kolenda's site.

We have Julian's personal ministry website, being made by Rodolfo (the developer of Daniel Kolenda's site), which will shortly going to be reviewed by the trustees for this decision to be made as to whether to use him for the Tree of Life as an addendum to this meeting within a few weeks and added to these minutes .

5. Harry's Tree of Life work update

Editors Note **HM** had prepared a full presentation that required screen share on the Zoom, and at this meeting, **JR** as the host, was unfortunately unable to get it to operate. So, we the trustees agree that the presentation prepared by **HM**

including the graphics, are included for information purposes in full, as an addendum to the minutes of this meeting with grateful thanks to **BM**.

So, at this trustees meeting, **HM** said he would give a brief summarization of his presentation, which follows;

JR Opened by asking a question left at the previous trustees meeting. He asked **HM** if there would still need to be a full six-month proof of concept for the Thinker software.

HM The Key is, the proof of concept is now completed.

We now have a basic Thinker demo version.

I have done consultancy work – I've had some spare time

I have used the spare time to develop Algorithms and Data stretchers

Me and John Lewis and will have gone through it, and it will save money in the development, JL predicts 40K.

It will give a better end product.

I have learnt also 2 new programming languages.

I found this could link the back end of thinker into **Discord Interface – it's a rival to Facebook** – its big within the gaming community.

You can click on the room and it can be private between you and friends.

I realised that this would be perfect for building community.

JR are you saying you can connect to it to use it within our app?

HM we can use it they allow you to build bits onto it, piggyback on top of it, so we can use the front end and only build the back end.

This means its is just backend that I need to worry about.

HM we can grow our own community without having a fully developed app.

I would like to get to a community starting at 10 and growing to around 10K so that we can get feedback from them as we develop.

This means we don't dump thousands of pounds into something that people don't like or use.

This is going to be significant when we talk to the trusts, as they will

want to see that we are already achieving our goals, and we will be able to illustrate that all the ideas we have been developing these years genuinely help.

HM then explained the benefit of having a working prototype, and showing to the public with the illustration of the wright brothers and the first airplane.

HM The strange advantage of discord is that I can loan people the use of the prototype.

I can give people access to the prototype, and use that to raise money.

Currently I am consulting with Lawyers, and a professor of Logic who use deductive arguments, have expressed interest in it. This could potentially be an income

stream. We could sell it via Patreon.

JR How can we decide how this can work if people start paying for this

JR We could make it that payments to HM came as a proportion of how this comes in to the Tree of Life charity. i.e. if £100 pounds comes in Harry could get £70, as an example, or £80 or whatever the rest to the Tree of Life.

HM This would have to be thought through carefully after the meeting.

JR We also need to consider the law on these payments.

JR how many rooms and what would they be called in Thinker in the demo version.

8 text rooms and 5 voice rooms.

JR can people go off into separate rooms.

BS I've never used discord.

HM we can set the rules for the rooms equivalent to keys. Moderation is going to not necessary with a smaller audience.

JR How does thinker's software work if it's on discord another person's software.

HM The key idea of the thinker software is helping people to think collectively, and that could be about abstract things like apologetics and theology, or it could be for everyday things.

Large numbers of people on discord play massive multiplayer video games. We could potentially rent them the use of their bot and that could help them to manage communal decision making – should their guild attack someone or invest in something?

6. Brents Tree of Life work update

BS Gave a brief presentation

BS About the testimonies. I have countless videos on popular platforms, YouTube, ministry sites and ministries etc

- Dozens of links to links (we need permissions to use)
- I created a key system to categorize whether the person healed has medical evidence, no medical evidence or potential medical evidence as part of the follow up process
- Collated the details of other links and websites online (worldwide) that have testimony content within various categories. These will be useful for requesting permissions, unique content or for linking to in the apps role as a hub.
- Reached out by email to individuals and linked them to our promo website by way of an introduction to the vision we have been given by the Lord and how we believe that allowing them to share their testimony with us could further the kingdom of God with global reach and impact.
- Also reached out to many Christians who already have a platform or platforms on social media that whether fully or in part includes testimonies (within *all* categories, not just healing and/or miracles) and shared the vision of the Tree of Life app with them. Potentially access to a significant number of testimonies (in particular those in the UK of the US) could be granted with one of these people on board. Some of the people that I have already approached, that have said that they do not currently have the time or that they would pray about it first, could be given another opportunity to get involved, when the new look promo website goes live.

Rutendo's video clips was discussed, which JR liked

HM Suggested that we can have more positive responses from friends and friends of friends (in addition to the other avenues we are pursuing, since there is some form of relationship already established)

HM we may need to think of legal permissions required to use these

BS It is something I have raised with people I have asked including doctors. In the content of my emails, I have requested that any sensitive information on documents would not be visible.

JR How many do we have with doctors' evidence?

BS I'm working on it. I will feel more confident when we have the new promo site up that we have previously approached, or reached out to will be more assured about who we are and that we are endorsed by CfaN

JR mentioned the CfaN Bonnke 'Raised from the Dead' testimony, which we could have as the flagship video.

JR Will **BS** use these two avenues to chase up for testimony links as he mentioned last year?

- The Wall testimony project, based at Chroma Church Leicester, pastored by Steve Barber
- David Chambers of Cfan UK.

JR mentioned he is now in contact with Steve Barber of Chroma Church, so it makes the link with the Wall of Prayer people easier as they are based there.

JR Also reminded Brent that we can contact **Dr Chauncy Crandall** about his testimonies of raising people from the dead, as well as **Sid Roth 'Its Supernatural'** TV producers and **CfaN's John Darku**, and we can do this straight after the revised website is live.



- Over the last 9 months I have built a basic version of thinker, whilst doing other consultancy projects.

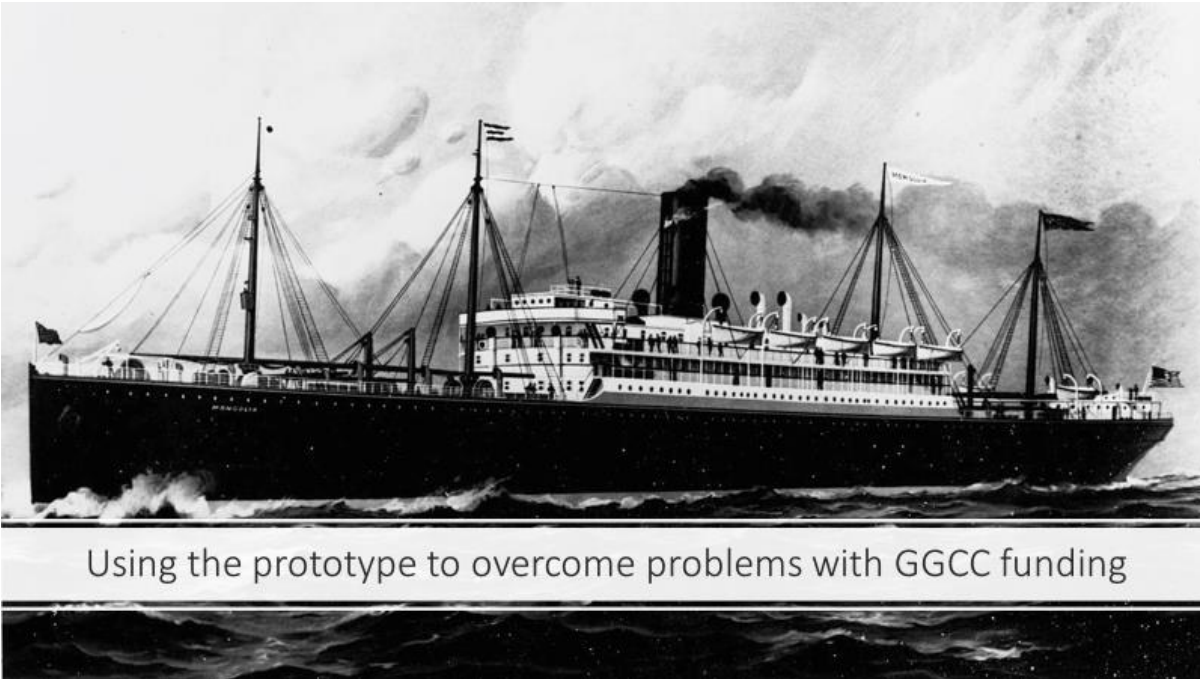

So far we've been a bit like the wright brothers – we want to build something that no one else can really imagine. But we've been able to see it prophetically and the effect its going to have.

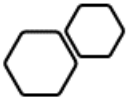
If the wright brothers had tried to raise money to build a 747 before their first flight – people would have properly been disinterested and said why can't you just build a boat

I believe that the prototype is something like the wright brothers first plane – its not a 747 and can't on its own give us an airtravel industry but it can advertise the technology, and the potential

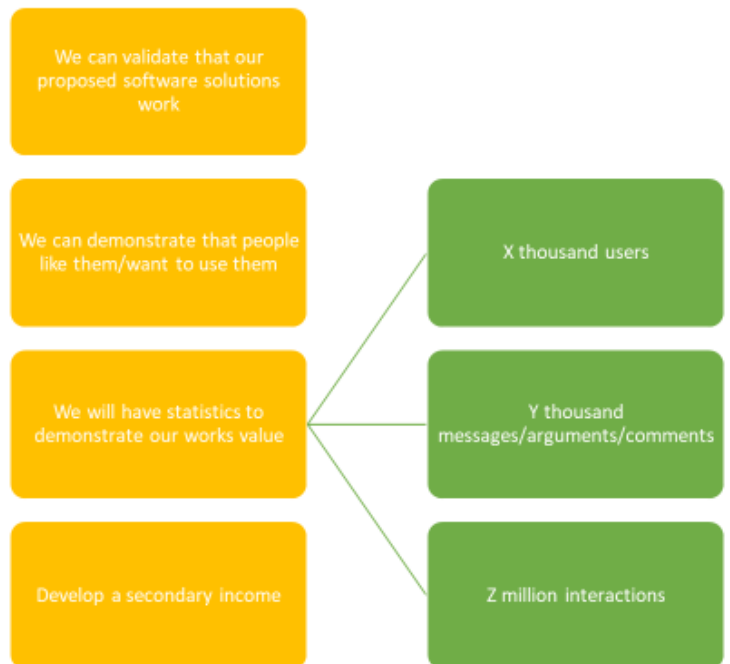
