Enable Busoga made significant financial contributions to FLEP throughout 2024 in support of their administration function from which their 50+ Health Centres are co-ordinated and supplied, finances are controlled and bids for specific project funding are prepared and managed. During the year, EB also contributed towards the cost of essential maintenance to one of their vehicles.

Enable Busoga continued to support tree planting at an increasing number of churches, schools and farms in Busoga through its Uganda partner Transcending Hope Uganda. The financing contributed towards the establishment of a tree nursery, the collection and purchasing of seeds, the transportation of tree seedlings, the training of personnel at each site on tree planting and aftercare together with regular and frequent performance monitoring during the months after planting.

A key leader of the tree planting community group was assisted with his on-going medical bills, which he would otherwise not have been able to afford.

Support of a local organisation called PAMENAS which assists girls to remain in education and equips them with skills such as tailoring and animal husbandry continued. In particular, funding was provided to assist in the re-build of their business hub which was destroyed by fire.

In Beni, North Kivu, DRC we provided funding through a local charity for a counselling service for women traumatised by the on-going conflict.

A key leader of the tree planting community group was assisted with his important medical bills, which he would otherwise not have been able to afford while a health worker was given a bereavement grant

Work with schools has now transferred to a local organisation called PAMENAS which assists girls to remain in education and equips them with skills such as tailoring and animal husbandry.

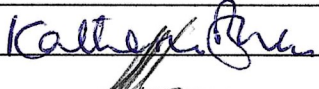

As reported last year, the work of the Barbara Project in its original form has now ceased and has now been incorporated under the auspices of FLEP (Family Life Education Programme). A small amount of funding was provided in 2022 to facilitate the change of responsibility.

Enable Busoga made significant financial contributions to FLEP throughout 2022 in support of their administration function from which their 50+ Health Centres are co-ordinated and supplied, finances are controlled and bids for specific project funding are prepared and managed.

Enable Busoga supported tree planting at a number of church sites in Busoga in a project delivered with funding from Climate Stewards. The financing covered the purchase and transportation of thousands of tree seedlings, the training of personnel at each site on tree planting and aftercare together with performance monitoring during the months after planting. The primary aim of the project was to sequester carbon for offsetting, though other benefits such as soil consolidation and increased agricultural yield are anticipated.

A key leader of the tree planting community group was assisted with his important medical bills, which he would otherwise not have been able to afford.

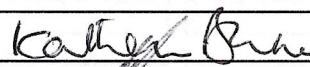

Enable Busoga Trustees' Annual Report for 2021

It was not possible for trustees to visit Uganda in connection with the Barbara Project in 2021 due to the Covid 19 extended lockdown in the country. The team based in Uganda were able to distribute the remaining outstanding pieces of equipment to children waiting on these.

It is with regret that as a result of Covid, the Uganda team have had to seek employment elsewhere meaning that they are no longer available to work for the Barbara Project. This effectively means that the work of the Barbara Project in the original form has now ceased but we are confident that this work will continue in a different form – probably under the auspices of FLEP (Family Life Education Programme).

Enable Busoga provided financial support to FLEP, enabling them to coordinate and provide Covid 19 vaccination services to the rural population via their health centres.

Enable Busoga supported tree planting at a number of church sites in Busoga. Talks took place with Climate Stewards - another NGO - to carry out a tree planting programme in 2022 with the primary aim of sequestering carbon. Meanwhile, funding was provided to plant regenerative crops on 12 farms. The aims of this were carbon sequestration and providing fodder for animals.

The PAMENAS Foundation, which supports and trains young people abandoned by their families, was given a grant to set up a piggery with the aim of generating income for the foundation.

Funding was provided to a rural school to purchase much needed computer equipment.

A grant was provided via ACDI (Action Chretienne pour le Developpement Integral) to a women's group in Beni, Eastern DRC. This was to support a microfinance programme for widows to set up small businesses.

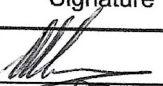
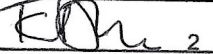

2020 saw the Covid pandemic hit Uganda very hard with lengthy, restrictive lockdowns closing schools, churches and workplaces with travelling and movement severely limited. All of our activities were affected. However, we were able to support a number of initiatives, including: financing Covid response workshops run by the Family Life Education Programme which provides health services throughout rural Busoga via 50+ health centres; providing start-up capital for a local initiative, the PAMENAS foundation, which will support and train young people abandoned by their families. A pilot programme was established to plant boundary, fruit and timber trees on church land at a number of sites. A cash crop Avocado plantation was also set up using a capital grant from EB. With another partner, further start-up capital was provided for a microfinance programme enabling women in the Beni district of DRC to establish small businesses.

Some of our trustees were able to visit Busoga in connection with the Barbara Project in February 2020 just before the first Covid lockdown. Assessment clinics for disabled children were carried out by the team in 5 rural village health centres. Mobility equipment in the form of wheelchairs crutches and shoe raises were issued to the children seen. Benson our rehab assistant and Stephen Kato our physiotherapy team based in Uganda were due to carry out further assessment clinics later in the year, however restrictions caused by the Covid 19 pandemic made this impossible. Some equipment that had been on order has been issued to children. To date due to the prolonged lockdown and school closures further assessment clinics have not been held.

During lockdown there have been changes to our Ugandan physiotherapy team which may have implications for the future of the project.

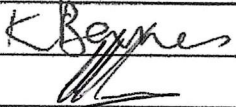
