Income was down this year due to the fact the previous years' income was the focus of our expenditure, ensuring grants were successfully implemented and the spend was maintained accurately.

Our donations increased by around 40% which was an effective way of offloading some decreases in our lower income forecast.

Our sales flatlined and reduced by over half, which was very disappointing and unplanned, we do believe we are feeling the effects of poor economic activity especially with budget constraints in some of our main selling markets e.g. schools and academies.
