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2025 Report

Another year has gone by and I've entered my 10th year here as senior Pastor but things are not the same as other years a lot has changed and all I trust for the Good. After my time in Kenya in 2024 I felt God telling me that it was time to spread out and do more. Over the last 4 years our evangelism has been to work in our feeding Program, which still goes on and many lives are being blessed, But God would have me start up The prayer meeting and bible study upon the night that some of the church family had got together for prayer via zoom in the past. I didn't know what sort of response I would get as I was asking people to come out of their warm homes and meet in the church. I needn't have worried for God knew that our time together would become such a special time. Gathering around the word of God in an atmosphere of easy conversation we would be able to discuss the chapter as we read it.

Other things have changed our Sunday school now has two designated young people who are on fire for God to help instruct our children. We might not have many but what they lack in numbers they make up for in enthusiasm.

I have drawn together three individuals who have the ability to become spiritual leaders looking after the spiritual life of the church along with myself, I guess they are ministers in training.

We have also started a mens and women group that is a spiritual time around the word. As I at the moment run the mens I take our group up to a local food establishment and have breakfast and then in the restaurant we have a bible study for all the people to see. We are taking the word of God out into the community.

During this year also we have had a film week in October where the films were meant to cause a reaction in the lives of the people that came. Everyone that came said that they got something out of the films although we saw no souls saved we are trusting that God would undertake.

During this year we had several open air services one was a shipwreck service where there were no song books or bibles and we had to hold a service as we were on the beach this was an ice breaker for our next open air service which was to be a come as you see as a bible character and I tell you there were some wonderful characters. Our final open air of the year was the Tuesdays before Christmas when we run our carol service again as we had it in the church we did it in the cold December night. Afterwards a man who lived in the road opposite came to thank us for making his Christmas, he went out into his garden and heard Christmas carols being sang and he thought he was tripping for now one come out singing Christmas carols anymore. What a blessing that was to hear and it warmed our cold heart to know that our testimony had touched someone's life.

This year we have stepped out of our comfort zone and God has blessed us. What will happen in the next year we will have to wait and see but this thing we know we won't be going backwards. Our saviour is the captain of our ship and where he leads we are about to follow.

We have also started a youth ministry youth drama and a youth Club all aimed at reaching out to the young people in the area this is headed up by Joe one of our ministers in training.



This has been both a joy and an encouragement from all the attend here. Who would have thought that the people who might be thought of as societies outcast or becoming a people who are giving time up out of their day to come and help. During this year we were giving the opportunity to run a house which was just a couple of doors up from the church. Much work was need to put this house back into order as the owner who had been ill had let it run down sum what. We were able to house a couple of people who had started to comet church who needed a home at a small rent. In the church much has stayed the same as we have continued to proclaim the gospel to the people in so many ways. Our church although small has big ideas and we have sen the hand of God come to bless us in many ways. We might only be a small congregation but each Sunday God is there in our service and many say just how God has blessed them. Next year i feel will be a crunch year for us as we what to see if our sowing the seed of the gospel in our community pays off Yes we know we have to sow the seed and it is God alone that brings the increase. As we sow into the fields around agbc we can see the small shoots of growth so we are encouraged.

Tuesday lunch

Our lunch day is always a very busy day as we have already pre and cooked meals for the feeding program and now we get to cook some more food for our special guest that come and have a sit down meal Our time together is always a lively affair as i murmur about how much sugar people put in the teas or coffees and how many cups they can drink in the two hour period. I don't really mind but we don't half get through some coffee, but when i take into consideration that many of the people that come don't have or can afford coffee i quickly stop my moaning. Food can be just what we have in the kitchen and this can range from pasta to potatoes all cook with love by our chef. Our time together is always finished with a time of prayer around the table. Its always wonderful to hear that they will ask for prayer for people and i always try to remember them all in our prayer time so that they feel special. Some might not give my lunch group the time of day but as i know that God would so then do we. I prayer that God will continue to bless our Tuesday lunch special as we gather together.

Poppy Club

This is a group that meet on the second and four Friday of each month, they meet for fellowship and a craft session and of course a cup of tea or coffee and a biscuit or cake and a chat. all different types of crafts are done and our time together finishes with a time of prayer. The table that we sit around seems to get bigger each week but there's always a space fore someone new. Our Group has continued to have the macmillan appeal day where cakes are sold to raise money and each year we do it our amount that we raise gets bigger. If your feeling alone and need the time to talking do some craft work why not come and spend just an hour from 10.30-11.30 with us and im sure you'll be blessed.

Sunday school

After a long break from Sunday school due to the fact that we had no children at our age God has blessed us with a family that have started to come to our church so Pastor has stopped telling the Bill Stickers stores even though we truly enjoyed them and we have started up again the Sunday school using two of our young people Hennesha and Joe to front this mission. Our time together has had its difficulties but we are slowly making head way with our young students.

Feeding program

This year our feeding program has gone from strength to strength and we are regularly feeding about 100 people away so we are cooking over 700 meals a week. We are continuing to get our food from Fareshare which help us as we help other. During this year we have added a new chef to our team and Trevor and he is fitting in just fine. Our meals are a combination rice pasta potato with veg and curry as a side. Volunteers are always in demand to make the work go easy so if your in a mind to give us a hand just pop in and ask for Trevor and he'll set you to work. Thanks to all our volunteers without your help we would be hard pressed to undertake the work we do Many thanks.

Missionary work

As a church we are still supporting Timnah and the work that she undertakes to do in Kenya from her in the UK. Things have been different since covid time and her visits to Kenya has not been as often but she has used the money that we have given her to help the christian Church in Kimengeti and the feeding program there. A building has also be erected with funds from the church to be used as a sunday school building for the children as there is not enough room in the church for them to meet with their Parents. Timnah has also sent money to help a struggling minister in Nairobi who has been suffering with his health. and has needed many operations with regards to bowl cancer. Goo to say that he's well on the mend and is back in the church.





Letter from the minister.

During this year i had the privilege to show to the church some films that for me were old but to the church here were quite new . Over three Sundays we showed A distant Thunder, a thief in the night and one more which slips my mind for the moment but each brought a challenge to the church and an awakening thinking of what is to come. God has promised to come again and receive to himself his bride which is us the church. Our Sunday services are well attended and the challenge of the gospel goes out with a clear call. Christ says that today is the day of salvation we may not have tomorrow so we should seize the day and act when the HOLY SPIRIT moves upon our lives. In February we once again had our gift day where the church would bring their best gift to God Once again we were able to raise over £10,000 which may not sound a lot but when you take into consideration the size of our congregation its a wonderful amount. Many thanks to all that where able to give and to those who were not able why don't you trust God and see what he will do for you as you put him to the test. Our God is faithful and if where faithful to him he will be to us even if were not faithful to him God is still faithful for he cannot change. During this year the word of God has been preached as the word of God is written without missing bits out from the Old testament to the New.

Feeding program

Again our numbers have increase and were serving over 600 meals a week little did we know that when God called us to do this work we would touch the lives of so many. as i look in our books we have server over 200 individuals with food that we have cooked. From little acorns mighty oak to spring and i remember when the Lord asked me to start this work all the way back in the month of February in 2020. Litle did we realise just what God had in store for us and without the help of our volunteers we would be unable to complete the task so thank you all our many volunteers.

Tuesday Lunch

Once again our kitchen has been a blur on a Tuesday after the feeding program we set forth we the luncheon. 

Many are the times when we feel that we will not be able to fulfil our obligations but by the Grace of God we do and we are always astounded. Thanks are given to all those who offer their help in the food program volunteers all but worth their weight in Gold and we say thanks.

Tuesday Lunch

Our numbers haven't yet reached the numbers of what they were before covid but we are seeing a steady trickle of people coming in to have a hot cooked meal which is two courses with a lot of banter between. Time is always given at the end of our session for prayer and we are seeing answers to prayers every week. We have a cross section of people come all with varying abilities but is great to see just how people get on with each other.

Sunday service

Pastor is always up the front leading our service and what a wonderful time we have. Our services are streamed just as they were when we were in covid lockdown times so that people who have to work or who are ill at home can still enjoy the service. Much time and effort is given so that the service seems to be seamless, From Pastor up the front to to the tech team at the back all seem to enjoy the meetings. The worship the message and even out time of giving is a time for rejoicing. No one in the service is ignored from the youngest to the oldest all have something that will bless them.

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



God has opened a door and we have just walked through it to bless people this is the amazing thing.

Tuesday Lunch

We have started this group up again that was on a Friday but this the date that was more practicable so we have changed but we have seen a different group gather so we are blessed. A two course meal which is usually a most of some kind has been received by the new people. They don't have to pay but if they can give little then we encourage people to do that. Money has never been the issue but the gathering together of people who need help is and it's great to see all kinds of people from different walks of life joining together.

Sunday Service

Getting back to some sort of normality is our prime objective and it's been great to see people gathering together in church. Our Pastor has been constant throughout the whole of covid time preaching the word and leading worship. It's been great to be inside the house of God and in the worship. God has been faithful to us all and we have come through an ordeal that was Covid. Gradually we are seeing people return as they feel safe. Our time together on a Sunday has been precious knowing that God who was faithful will continue to be faithful. Thanks to all those who make our Sunday encounter with God a real experience.

Kenya

Since Timnah has come back from Kenya her activities have been stand somewhat but she has still seen fit to contact all those that she worked with in Kenya to see that they are alright and if they have needed anything Timnah hasn't been sort in giving the help. As yet Timnah has no plans to return to Kenya as when she left she had not received her work permit even though they had awarded her it. 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
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
