ANNUAL REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR 1ST SEPTEMBER 2020 TO 31ST AUGUST 2021

The Trustees met via telephone and e Zoom links on several occasions during the above period due to the restrictions of Covid19 and continue to be satisfied with the progress that the Charity made in the year in regard to the museum collection, conservation, display and limited public outreach together with the financial stability of the Charity. The Trustees report that there have been no incidents affecting the status of the Charity or breaches of their responsibilities in spite of the severe limitations placed upon the Charity by the Governments Covid 19 controls.

Turning to the income and expenditure account the Trustees are advised by the Treasurer and the Honorary Auditor that the year shows a healthy surplus resulting from prudent financial management. Subscription and donation income remain high with the additional benefit of the receipt of Gift Aid. Money on deposit continues to attract little interest but the Trustees continue to be opposed to any diversification on investments at this time.

Expenditure is contained well within the income stream which includes Covid19 grants received between 1st April 2020 and 31st August 2020. Total reserves stand at £26,943.29 of which £7,918.66 is set aside for restoration project work and £10,238.82 for the potential unknown costs associated with the running and demonstration of the Charity's exhibits. The accounts for the year are self explanatory and have been prepared in that manner.
