
Reserves policy

Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Emdee Charitable Trust

I report on the accounts of Emdee Charitable Trust for the year ended 31 March 2022, which are set out on pages 4 to 7.

Respective responsibilities of trustees and examiner

Basis of Independent examiner's report
