### Sharing for Peace

#### Signing of the Faith Covenant

On 13 November 2024, during Interfaith Week, faith groups from across Cornwall came together at Lys Kernow in Truro to sign Cornwall's new Faith Covenant. This is a joint commitment between Cornwall Council and Cornwall's faith communities to work together to support Cornwall residents. The Faith Covenant is a significant milestone in our partnership with our faith communities. It highlights our shared values and the desire to help bring communities together and promote a sense of pride in Cornwall's diversity. Members of the Baha'i, Buddhist, Christian, Hindu, Islam, Jewish, and Pagan faiths, alongside a representative from the Humanist community signed the Covenant document on behalf of their communities. The Covenant was also signed by Cllr Linda Taylor, Leader of Cornwall Council and Kate Kennally, Chief Executive on behalf of Cornwall Council and Andrew Yates (Chair) on behalf of Cornwall Faith Forum.

#### Holocaust Memorial Day

On 27<sup>th</sup> January marked the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the liberation of Auschwitz-Birkenau, the largest Nazi death camp. The annual service was held at Truro Cathedral. Kehillat Kernow stated 'A very moving and well-attended service took place in Truro Cathedral on that day under the theme 'For A Better Future'. - Wesak Celebration, by the Buddhist Faith Community – 11<sup>th</sup> May 2025
- Shavuot, by the Jewish Faith Community – 1<sup>st</sup> June 2025 where the Biblical story of Ruth and Naomi was enacted by Kehittat Kernow members followed by delicious food.

## Building for Peace



During the year we continue to meet at the Dor Kemmyn Field (see details above) around our faith poles. These poles make a conspicuous presence to passers by and we are shortly having 2 notice boards erected giving information about the Cornwall Faith Forum and the poles.

Moving forward a suggestion has been made of erecting a Gazebo/Summerhouse construction e.g. view here: <https://www.crownpavilions.com/> Although smaller than our proposed DK Oval, it could provide shelter and the cost feels as if it could be achievable. We have yet to ask the Penmount staff whether they would approve of such a structure. AY asked the meeting whether this was an idea that would be favourable. All those present agreed that this would be a way forward and were in agreement with this suggestion. AY will now set up a task and finish group to proceed with this idea, subject to agreement of Penmount staff.

## Learning for Peace

The contract for our Inter Faith Education Co-ordinator had to be ended in August 2024 as the funding ran out and we were not able to secure another grant to extend the work.

In the year an Inter Faith Workshop was run at Penclenick Special School and this was much appreciated by the school – staff and pupils.

Currently we are undertaking online Faith literacy training for Cornwall Council staff. KP also kindly met with the Little Harbour, St Austell to provide training for working with different faiths.

**SHARING FOR PEACE**

We maintained our practice of holding monthly gatherings at the Peace Field at Penmount with celebrations of Festivals and Special Holy Times led by different Faith Communities

**LEARNING FOR PEACE**

In July we said farewell to Rita Stephen who for over 12 years has worked for CFF as our Inter Faith Development Worker with a special emphasis on Education. In the six months Rita was in post she delivered a series of Workshops via Zoom which reached over 600 hundred college students from Truro College. She also created some video recordings of faith leaders which are for use in Primary Schols across Cornwall. We thanked Rita for her enormous contribution to CFF over the years – highlighting the work co-ordinating Faith Forum members in the welcoming of Syrian Refugees as well as the faith awareness sessions in schools.

In September we welcomed Chis Ashby-Zwozdiak as the new Inter Faith Education Co-ordinator and she has taken up the mantle and is making links with schools and starting to add to the video collection of interviews about faith.

We offer thanks to St Luke's Trust and the Association of Jewish Refugees for their grant funding of some of our Education Work

**BUILDING FOR PEACE**

In June we replaced the wooden posts that marked out the area planned for the Dor Kemmyn Centre for Peace and Faith with a series of Peace Poles. The design was based on the Peace Pole project that are now well known across the earth.

We asked each Faith Community to design a pole with images and phrases linked to that faith. And we also invited a number of our partner organisations to design a pole too including Forest for Cornwall, United Nations Association, CHAOS and the Penmount Crematorium staff team.

This now makes a very visible display to any one visiting Penmount and completes Phase 1 of the CFF Dor Kemmyn Development project. We are currently reviewing Phase 2 of this development and considering whether a timber construction might be more appropriate than the tent design proposed in the original document. Investiagations into costings and grant funding for phase 2 continue.

## **CORNWALL FAITH FORUM ANNUAL REPORT APRIL 2022 TO MARCH 2023**

It has been another busy year for the Cornwall Faith Forum and as we emerged from the pandemic restrictions we have been glad to have been able to do more face to face contact. The three strands of Sharing for Peace, Learning for Peace and Building for Peace have all seen interesting developments in these 12 months

### **SHARING FOR PEACE**

The monthly pattern of holding events at Penmount - during the Spring and Summer months has returned and this year included

- Christian celebration of Palm Sunday
- Celebration of Eid with family games
- Diversi-tea to mark the Queen's Jubilee
- Autumn Equinox on the theme of balance led by our Pagan community

In November we went indoors and together created an Advent Spiral and we discovered that the theme of light and darkness was common to all our faith traditions

CFF had significant participation in the planning for the Holocaust Memorial Day and in the event itself in January in Truro Cathedral - with lighting of Memorial Candles by the Chair of Kehillat Kernow and a presentation on the Yellow Crocus project from Mousehole School

### **LEARNING FOR PEACE**

With COVID restrictions lifted we were able to return to more regular delivery of Faith Education sessions in schools - though we also continued to use the on-line platforms we had begun to use during the pandemic. These meant we could be more efficient with our time and also support our environment policy

Specific projects to highlight from the year.

**Primary.** A set of videos were made of interviews with Faith leaders. The interviews were based on questions that had been submitted by local RE teachers through the LTRE scheme in Cornwall

These videos were watched by schools during National Inter Faith Week.

Going forward we hope to record more interviews so each Faith Community is represented. And we are looking for follow up questions from pupils to the answers given in response to the initial questions from teachers.

We supported Mousehole School to become part of the Yellow Crocus Project

Holocaust Memorial Day Service in Truro Cathedral with a moving address by the acting Dean was attended by students from Torpoint who displayed their work and also pupils from Mousehole School who talked about planting the crocuses and the link to the yellow stars.

**Secondary** The Stories of Survival Project goes from strength to strength and resources have been developed for Secondary Schools for Holocaust Education. CFF has brought together Torpoint School which is recognised nationally as a Beacon School for Holocaust Education ; a member of Kehillat Kernow whose mother was a Holocaust Survival ; and Falmouth University Animation Department to produce these resources

They were introduced to teachers from some secondary schools for their feedback at a landmark conference hosted by the University

And the animations went on to win an award

Going forward the feedback from the teachers will be used to adapt and improve the materials and then given wider circulation

**College** With funding from St Luke's Trust we continued to develop our links with the Colleges. We produced a series of recordings from college age students under the title This Time Tomorrow ie. What difference does following a faith path have on our daily lives. And these were used as part of the delivery of An online workshop for 1,000 children (16-17 year old ) in conjunction with Truro College.to a whole year group of students via their tutor groups.

## **BUILDING FOR PEACE**

The report that the CFF Trustees had commissioned from Paul Green into the viability of the Dor Kemmyn Centre for Peace and Faith was submitted to the Bereavement Services of Cornwall Council and was received positively. It envisages a three stage project.

Phase 1 – Replace the tired wooden poles marking the oval with a new set of poles – based on the peace pole - designed by each faith community and by our CFF partners.

Phase 2 – A temporary shelter perhaps with a sail type roof supported by wooden poles – along the lines of the SERTS theatre on Bodmin Moor

Phase 3 - . The timber framework from Phase 2 would be used to develop the final Dor Kemmyn Oval, with the walls being constructed with cob bricks, made by community, faith and other groups and organisations.

The Council endorsed this approach which allowed us to have an extension of the offer to Lease the field and we also set about enthusiastically inviting each faith community and several of our partners to consider designs for 'their' poles. By March 2023 several designs were at the completed stage and discussions were in hand with a local printer on producing the poles with hopes of a celebration for their installation in Summer 2023.

## **CORNWALL FAITH FORUM ANNUAL REPORT AND Review of 2021:**

### **Sharing for Peace**

**COP 21 Walk, 10<sup>th</sup> April** – A walk was held in the Kenwyn, Truro vicinity with an environment theme focusing on the forthcoming COP26 taking place in the Autumn. There were two groups of six participating. The walk commenced at the grave of Joseph Emidy at Kenwyn Church and progressed down the valley onto the outskirts of Truro. The weather was beautiful. Readings regarding the environment were given from the different faith communities at various stops along the walk trail.

**Story-telling event for 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of first Race Amity event, 11<sup>th</sup> September 2021** – This event was led by Philomena Clifford from the Baha'i faith in commemoration of the 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the first Race Amity event. Stories from the participating faith communities were told on the theme of reconciliation and there were a variety of stories, some personal and some related to individual faiths. It was felt this was an excellent event by all those who took part.

**Dialogue on the conception of the Divine – Sunday, 24<sup>th</sup> October** at Chacewater Village Hall. (JJ) advised that the event was a collaboration with Kehillat Kernow and CFF and is part of the European Days of Jewish Culture and Heritage. The theme was dialogue and the topic between the faiths was the conception of the divine. Four different faiths were represented and the speakers were from the Jewish, Muslim, Christian and Buddhist faiths. It was pleasing that there was a good attendance at the event. It was felt that the speakers were excellent and a good spirit of sharing. There were good and respectful questions from the audience. It is hoped that there will be a second event of a similar vein to be held in February/March 2022 with speakers from the Baha'i, Hindu and Pagan faith communities.

### **Building for Peace**

RS reported that during the period of lockdown once the restrictions allowed that prayers were said at the DKO field by the Dome of Human Kindness. These were held on Thursdays at 1.00 pm. She felt that

**Tree Planting, Dor Kemyrn Peace Field, 6<sup>th</sup> November** – Two trees were planted. One was a Hawthorne tree by the Christian faith community. The second was a replacement for the Hindu tree which had sadly been eaten by the deer. A recording of a chant by Yoti was recorded and played by the new tree which was special. It was noted that we have been planting trees for seven years.

In 2022 we will renew our commitment to meet at the DK field monthly to commemorate various events/festivals etc.

### **Learning for Peace**

RS advised that it has been difficult to plan visits to schools owing to Covid. Several visits had to be cancelled owing to the prevalence of Covid in the school.

RS was pleased to advise that the CFF have been successful in receiving funding from St Luke's for a project called 'This time tomorrow'. The project will comprise recording interviews with different faith individuals advising how faith affects their daily lives,

particularly in relation to their work. Currently she had interviewed ES (Pagan community) and invited CFF members to participate. She asked for support with the editing of the recording and asked if anyone could help.

**Holocaust Education** – RS informed the meeting of a current joint project between CFF, Kehelliat Kernow, Falmouth University and SACRE. Last year two animations had been made by the students concerning the survival of Blanka (mother of Kehelliat Kernow member Cynthia Hollingsworth) who survived Auschwitz. (RS) advised that Cynthia Hollingsworth and herself are now working with two groups of 2<sup>nd</sup> year students on new animations about the life of Blanka's family before World War 2. These will form part of a secondary school pack and will be launched in summer 2022. A teacher symposium will be held on 8<sup>th</sup> June 2022 at Falmouth University.

+Philip Mounstephen advised the meeting that following the report into global Christian persecution which he led, that the UK Freedom of Religion and Belief (FoRB) Forum has been set up. For further information see: <https://www.ukforbforum.org/> This Forum meets monthly comprising approximate 50 stake holder groups from all faith traditions. He felt that that this Forum is an excellent example of people of faith and non belief working together.



## **ANNUAL REPORT FOR APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> 2020 TO MARCH 31<sup>ST</sup> 2021**

Like so many charities and community groups Cornwall Faith Forum has been severely impacted by the pandemic in its activities during this year. However we still maintained connections between the communities thanks to internet communications and there were activities in all three of our key strands of working.

### **LEARNING FOR PEACE**

Despite the pandemic there has been schools work which included work at Pencalenick School and a faith debate at Truro and Penwith College.

Funding had been secured from the Southhall Trust for faith workshops in primary schools.

There is currently exciting work being undertaken with the Falmouth University working with the animation department students in producing a short film of the Holocaust testimony of Blanka Engelberg, late mother of Kehillat Kernow member Cynthia Hollinsworth. The aim is for the students to produce two short videos (less than two minutes each). The videos were shown as part of an on-line gathering for Holocaust Memorial Day (HMD) on January 27<sup>th</sup> and will also be part of pack produced for HMD for secondary schools in Cornwall.

### **SHARING FOR PEACE**

#### **Refugee Support**

Our contract with Cornwall Council to support the integration of Syrian Refugee families into the wider community finished in Summer 2019. However some of the volunteers are still visiting the families to help with the children's English and writing. We thank the volunteers for their continued dedication and support to the families.

**Interfaith Exploration Group** This group has continued to explore together issues from our different faith perspectives with topics such as 'Peace and Conflict in our faith traditions'. The format normal takes that a member presents a reflection of their faith tradition and the rest of the group offer their insights and questions in a way respecting and honouring the presenter's tradition. At the end of each session there's an opportunity for each member to identify something they have learned to enable change, growth and development.

### **BUILDING FOR PEACE**

The pandemic has severely restricted our activities at the Penmount Field. Our Inter Faith Development Worker maintained a pattern of prayers every Thursday during lockdown on-line and

monthly, when the restrictions were lifted, prayers were said beside the Dome of Human Kindness. This had helped strengthen the bonds between the Faith Communities at this challenging time.

Paul Green, who is currently researching funding for the building, has not progressed as he would have liked to as funding is currently mostly focussed around poverty. Also owing to the restrictions, he has not been able to speak to the communities. He will pick up the work next year when hopefully restrictions will have been lifted.

As Chair of the Board of Trustees I would like to express my thanks to my fellow trustees Eve Salthouse, Duried Rifai, Philomena Clifford, Kathy Pope, Babs Rounsevell for their support during this difficult period.


