

The Charity has published provisions as accessible as possible to all who could benefit from the training and advice offered.

We have continued to support research locally in different regions to therapists and counsellors with a view to developing a growing evidence base for counselling in prisons that is consistent with our charitable objects. We have sought to continue providing leadership in this field as well as in other publications and networks.
