The objectives of the CIO are: 1) the prevention or relief of poverty 2) the advancement of education 3) the relief of those in need because of youth, ill health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage worldwide and in particular to the benefit of children living without secure or adequate accommodation in the streets, slums and refuse areas of Manila in the Philippines.

Fundraising events in the UK (London) and transfer of funds to the Tnk Foundation in Manila to buy food (mainly rice), pay for medicine, pay for other needs of the foundation within the scope of its mission.

In 2023, Anak-Tnk UK was able to collect GBP 18,345 and to transfer GBP 15,288 to the Tnk Foundation in Manila to help buying rice and other basic goods and medicine for the street children of Manila.

Anak-Tnk has no other fixed costs than the monthly bank account fees of less than GBP100/year. Each year, Anak-Tnk UK tries to consistently send approximately between GBP15,000 and 20,000 to the Tnk Foundation as it is crucial for the foundation to be able to offer a stable and secure environment to its benefactors.

Anak-Tnk UK has a cash position of GBP 13,990 as at 31/12/2023. Anak-Tnk UK has a sound financial position at the end of 2023, as it has cash only and no debt.


