In planning for this year we have kept in mind our main objectives set out in the governing document/ guidance on public health.
Shine Bright Foundation have continued our relationship with Navitas based in Shavington . A centre of excellence in holistic treatments.
These treatments are there for people who have been diagnosed or are having ongoing treatment for breast cancer.
Reiki, reflexology and mindfulness are some of the treatments on offer.
We also provide a course to learn reiki up to level 1 to enable people to self help after their paid for treatments have finished. This is proving very successful and we are finding an continued demand for our services.
All paid for by Shine Bright Foundation.
While our main focus is to raise money to provide these treatments locally, we do from time to time help people outside our area of Crewe and Nantwich.
We are also well placed to offer grants to the Christie Foundation Trust centre research dept Manchester headed by Sacha Howell.
We also promote self care through social media.

For the year 2020/ 21- November 2020 to October 2021.

Our year continued with our objectives and with the ease of Covid19 we were able to offer our holistic treatments through our practitioners.

We were able to continue to provide our gift bags to any one going through breast cancer...

These gift bags contain Aloe Vera products, Tooth gel, Deodorant, Moisturiser, Antibacterial hand gel. Herbal tea and cosy socks.

We aim to send out 10 gift bags per month

We sent out 192 gift bags for this year.

We are also providing mastectomy pillows that sit under your arm to relieve any soreness or pressure to that area where a person has had surgery. These again are proving to be warmly received.

Part of the money we raise goes directly towards research into triple negative breast cancer and other breast cancer related illnesses.

Last year we were in the great position to offer £50.000 to Dr Sacha Howell's team .An early detection breast cancer app..Due to complications that money didn't clear until this financial year 2020/21.

We were very lucky to have continued support via a few fund raising events and donations, but there is still a considerable reduction on donations from the Covid fall out. As always we are very hopeful thing will change for the better this following year.

All money raised, is held within a Natwest bank account. This account is controlled by Joshua Bennett and Thomas Baker. Any expenses are reimbursed only when receipts are offered up, and only pertinent to the charities business.

We do not have any investment policies as all money raised provides grants into research of breast cancer and other business set out in our aims.


