Activities: provide financial relief to parents in the UK who cannot afford a memorial headstone for their stillborn baby, by providing funding towards the costs of a headstone and the provision of memory bears, memory boxes and equipment whilst raising awareness of the impact of pregnancy and baby loss with a view to bringing comfort to bereaved parents and their families after the loss of a baby.
