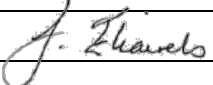

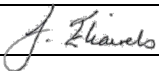

The Charity seeks to advance its purpose by holding a variety of innovative but simple events that promote the observance of the Sabbath and that, in particular, seek to attract people to experience one night a week where they can spend a few hours without the distraction of the modern world (away from busy jobs and the distractions of social media), where they can enjoy the company of family and friends and of the wider community.

Many of these events take place on Friday night itself or at other times of the week to prepare for the Friday night. The events are open to all and have a social aspect that would be underpinned by formal religious teachings regarding the observation of the Sabbath. These activities equate to a modern and more inclusive and engaging approach to religious teaching, of the type which has always taken place on the Sabbath.

Financial Review

The Charity has prepared its annual return on a receipts and payments basis. In summary this showed donations received of £nil, with grants made of £nil, leaving cash in the bank of £1,345.

Funds held as custodian trustee on behalf of others

The Charity does not hold any such funds.

Achievements and performance

Due to the ongoing impact of the COVID-19 pandemic the charity did not undertake any activities in the year.
