There is a wait list for our provision.</p> <p>In October 2022 we were inspected by Ofsted and were rated as "Good", and the report highlighted the "impressive learning opportunities outdoors" we offer.</p> <p>We have extended our outdoor play areas to give even more opportunities for outdoor play. Inside, we have invested in new flooring.</p> <p>It was great to get back to "in person" events, with a highly successful sponsored walk around Woodford Park to raise funds for a defibrillator in February 2023, a summer games day, and a leaver's picnic which was enjoyed by all.</p> <p>We've also piloted surveys to understand better how parents feel about our provision.</p>




