TRUSTEE ANNUAL STATEMENT

The Main objective of the Trust's sixth financial year was to maintain enough funds & support to ensure the upkeep, maintenance, running cost & ground rent of the Holiday home purchased in its previous financial year.

This once again provided a holiday home with facilities & respite for children with cancer and their families.

The Trust has also continued to offer sibling packs to families on initial diagnosis to help comfort family's children on admission to hospital. The siblings gift boxes will be tailored to an age group from 2yrs -16yrs old which are designed to help siblings cope with the emotions associated with the diagnosis of cancer. This would hopefully act as a kind of support mechanism.

The Trust continues to liaise with both children's hospitals with the support of Click Sargent (QMC Nottingham & Sheffield) to offer families the Evie's Retreat holiday home free of charge. However, due to the impact of Covid-19 Restrictions, the use of Evie's Retreat has been somewhat limited.

The Trustee's confirm that we referred to the guidance contained in the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit when reviewing the Trust's aims and objectives and in planning future activities.

The Charity has unfortunately suffered its first deficit on income versus expenditure in 6 years. This was due to the impact of Covid-19 restrictions and lack of fundraising. Thankfully, due to the funds accumulated and retained over the previous years, the trust has achieved its objective of keeping up with the maintenance, ground rent and utility bills for Evie's Retreat. Financially the trust is in a stable position going forward.

It is the trusts' objective in its seventh year to maintain its healthy position, whilst attempting to start raising funds during this difficult time due to Covid-19. This will ensure the trust can continue to support the running cost of the holiday home with a view to purchasing a second one in the future. Fundraising will also ensure that the good work with the supply of sibling packs and small gifts at festive periods like Easter & Christmas can be sustained.

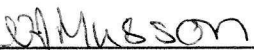

ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting Convention

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with Accounting and Reporting by Charities Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102 section 1a) and the Charities Act 2011

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention with items recognised at cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant note to these accounts.

Preparation of consolidated financial statements

The financial statements contain information about Princess Evie's Trust as an individual charity and do not contain consolidated financial information as the parent of a group. The company has taken the option under Section 398 of the Companies Act 2006 not to prepare consolidated financial statements.

Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds – are general funds which can be used in accordance with the charitable objects at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds – income received for restricted purposes is included in a separate restricted fund against which appropriate expenditure is allocated.

Designated funds – are allocated out of restricted funds by the trustees for specific purposes. The use of such funds is at the trustees' discretion.

Income

Grants receivable – Grants made to finance the activities of the charity are credited to the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate.

Investment income is included in the Statement of Financial Activities on receipt.

Other Income – sales of services are included in the Statement of Financial Activities in the period to which they relate. Other income, including donations, gifts and covenants are included as they are received.

Deferred Income – Grants received in advance of the period in which the funder requires the expenditure to be applied, will be reflected in deferred income within the balance sheet. Where entitlement to a grant is conditional on expenditure being incurred for a specific purpose, then the grant is also reflected in deferred income until the related expenditure is incurred.

Grants received for the restricted purpose of providing fixed assets are accounted for immediately as restricted funds. Where the fixed assets' acquisition discharges the restriction, the assets will be held in unrestricted funds. If the use of the assets is unrestricted the trustees, consider creating a designated fund reflecting the book value of the assets is appropriate. The relevant fund will then be reduced over the useful economic life of the asset in line with its depreciation.

Expenditure

All expenditure is accounted for on an accrual's basis. Expenditure includes any irrecoverable VAT and is reported as part of the expenditure to which it relates. All expenditure directly related to the provision of services is included within charitable expenditure. Other costs incurred have been allocated between costs of generating funds and governance costs as appropriate.

Charitable expenditure comprises those costs incurred by the charity in the delivery of its activities and services to its beneficiaries. It includes both costs that can be allocated directly to such activities and those costs of an indirect nature necessary to support them.

Governance costs include those costs associated with meeting the constitutional and statutory requirements of the charity and include independent examiner's fees and costs linked to the strategic management of the charity.

Tangible Fixed Assets

Depreciation will be provided at the following annual rates in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life:

Freehold Land	- not depreciated
Freehold property (caravan)	- 15 % straight line over the remaining period of the lease
Improvements to leasehold property	- straight line over the remaining period of the lease

- No Depreciation was applied during financial Year Ending 30 September 2020 as Evie's Retreat had not depreciated in value.

Financial Instruments

The company only has financial assets and financial liabilities of a kind that qualify as basic financial instruments. Basic financial instruments are initially recognised at transaction value and subsequently measured at their settlement value.
