<p>Summary of the main achievements of the charity, identifying the difference the charity’s work has made to the circumstances of its beneficiaries and any wider benefits to society as a whole.</p>	<p>Para 1.20</p>	<p>During the 2024–25 financial year, SWIM Cambodia strengthened its support for local delivery of drowning-prevention activities in alignment with Cambodia’s emerging national strategy. Working through its partner Hile Teuk Kampuchea (HTK) and alongside UNICEF Cambodia and the RNLI, the organisation focused on building local capacity, improving community outreach, and preparing for large-scale survival-swimming and water-safety programming.</p> <p>Across the year, more than 570 children and 250 adults received water-safety education, and 390 children were trained in CPR. Thirty-two teachers became Water Safety Educators, and volunteer development accelerated.</p> <p>HTK continued to mature as Cambodia’s leading drowning-prevention organisation, improving its communications, strengthening relationships with provincial education authorities, and deepening engagement with schools and communities. SWIM Cambodia encourage strategic collaboration with UNICEF with HTK supporting national programme planning and policy alignment, while RNLI training helped reinforce HTK’s technical and organisational capabilities.</p> <p>SWIM Cambodia, HTK and RNLI were invited by UNICEF and the Cambodian Ministry of Interior to lead a drowning preparation workshop, which took place in January 2025. Leads from the Ministry of Health and Monistry of Education, Youth &amp; Sports, local municipal leaders learned about drowning and drowning prevention. A scoping visit to Run Ta Ek, Siem Reap was made in preparation for the forthcoming programme implementation.</p> <p>Throughout 2024–25, significant progress was made toward the launch of a Survival Swimming education programme, planned for late 2025. While challenges remain—particularly around funding sustainability, infrastructure gaps, and the need for continued curriculum integration—the year marked a strategic turning point. SWIM Cambodia enters 2025–26 with stronger</p>

		partnerships, enhanced local leadership, and a clearer pathway toward delivering survival-swimming at national scale.



Para 1.20	<p>In 2023, SWIM Cambodia worked in partnership with a local non-governmental organisation (NGO) called 'Hile Teuk Kampuchea' (HTK). During this time SWM Cambodia trained HTK in the delivery of Water Safety, Safe Rescue and Resuscitation education. In December 2023, 10 new volunteers were trained bringing the total to 12 active trainers. 288 children and 10 adults were educated in Siem Reap, Cambodia.</p> <p>SWIM Cambodia continue to support HTK with technical advisory support, training, and funding. It is expected that SWIM Cambodia will expand it's drowning prevention interventions through operational delivery by HTK.</p>




Para 1.20	<p>SWIM Cambodia's activities began again post pandemic.</p> <p>During the financial year, 2022-23, SWIM Cambodia worked in partnership with International NGO, Helpcode, for the delivery of Water Safety, Safe Rescue and Resuscitation education to 2,513 children and young people and 140 adult caregivers, through three teachers. SWIM Cambodia provided technical support and refresher training to Helpcode.</p> <p>SWIM Cambodia trustees continued to work on localisation developing a local board of directors with a new Cambodian non-governmental organisation called 'Hile Teuk Kampuchea (HTK). HTK were registered with the Cambodian ministry of interior on 19<sup>th</sup> September 2022. SWIM Cambodia are supporting HTK with technical advisory support, recruitment, training, and funding. It is expected that SWIM Cambodia will expand drowning prevention interventions, with operational delivery by HTK.</p>

During 2020/21, SWIM Cambodia's work was impacted greatly by the the Covid-19 pandemic. With schools closed through the majority of the year SWIM Cambodia's partners were unable to deliver education in schools or other community settings.

The SWIM Cambodia trustees have spent time in the development of a National NGO board and worked on registration. Much of this work has been undertaken remotely.

Planning and discussions have continued with our two delivery partners, Helpcode and Youth Star.

In order to maintain the safety of our volunteers, delivery partners and trustees, Safety When It Matters have followed English and Cambodian government guidance to prevent the spread of Covid-19. Throughout this period, trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit.

Safety When It Matters (SWIM Cambodia) are exploring national registration in Cambodia. This will enable SWIM Cambodia to enter into agreements with National education agreements as well as employing a team of trainers to grow opportunities and capacity. The SWIM Cambodia trustees have invested time in the development of a National NGO board and worked on registration.

SWIM Cambodia will hold in reserve sufficient funds that we are able to fulfil our contractual obligations to any employees on a fixed term contract. SWIM Cambodia currently estimates this to be £3,000.



