Reading Edge Africa is a charitable incorporated organisation governed under the foundation model constitution for a charitable incorporated organisation. Our registration number is **1161361** under the Charities Commission.

Reading Edge Africa is funded through private donations. The majority of fundraising activities are undertaken by the trustees, and a secured database of donors and patrons is kept up to date. Most donors are known to the trustees as personal connections. The volunteers undertake fundraising activities under the supervision of the trustees.
