The organisation of Ecole Tricolore has changed as we have appointed Eugenie Mye as new Secretary in replacement of Cecile Neulat.

The Headteacher is still responsible for the overall leadership and management of the school.

The Headteacher is also responsible for the formulation of the strategic development of the school, curriculum or organisational change as well as recruitment working closely with the Secretary and the Treasurer.

The Treasurer develops reserves policy and safeguard the school finances, oversees the school budgets and the accounts along with the Headteacher.

The Secretary is responsible for the general communication with members of the charity, the staff and any person working along with the charity, the implementation of any regulations/procedures deemed necessary for the school to operate safely and effectively.

Ecole Tricolore has renewed its membership with the Association "Parapluie FLAM" (Charity number 1155089) which provides support and establish cooperation between the many organisations like Ecole Tricolore in the UK.

The charity's goals are to advance, help and support education of children in the French language and culture in such ways as the Trustees shall think fit.

The children learn how to speak, read, understand and write in French in small classrooms taking into account their age and abilities.

The main activity provided by Ecole Tricolore is to provide French lessons to children.

Ecole Tricolore provides French lessons in two different structures both located in the Borough of Bromley.

- A Saturday school based in West Wickham : lessons of three hours for children between 2.5 and 15 years old.
- A Wednesday after-school club based in Bromley : lessons of one hour and a half for children between 4 and 10 years old.

Both structures are offering French lessons during school term (10 sessions per term over 3 terms).

As stated in the Charity's governing document, Ecole Tricolore is primarily aimed at children having at least one French speaking parent.

Ecole Tricolore also has classrooms for children whose French is below average but who are ready to improve.

At Ecole Tricolore, we make sure that all children have access to help and support in order to succeed.

In accordance with the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit, the Trustees of Ecole Tricolore ensure that no pupil will be disadvantaged by their academic abilities or their ability to pay the fees. Families in difficult circumstances can be granted fee reductions or favourable methods of payments (instalments).

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Ecole Tricolore has welcomed 155 students between 2.5 and 15 years old.

There are 13 classes on Saturdays with the Wednesday after school club.

Our website remains our main source of advertisement.

Parents also spread the word about our school and what we offer which is very valuable to them.

We have been able to resume preparation for the DELF exams after the pandemic. Our students have been very successful with an average rate of 92%. DELF is an official diploma certifying the French language level of a child so that he/she can join a French school later. We have been working in partnership with the London French Institute, which every year allocates places to the students of FLAM schools like Ecole Tricolore for the exam.

The educational team is encouraged to diversify their teaching and their activities, using all kinds of supports. With the teaching of academic French, we also aim at providing relaxing, fun lessons.

We also encourage the team to attend regular trainings (some of which are mandatory) offered by Parapluie FLAM all year long.

That year, staff members were able to attend mandatory online safeguarding training.
