Aim and objection

The object of the Charitable Incorporated Organisation is, for the public benefit, the advancement of the Christian faith among Vietnamese in particular.

Activities

The Trust organises Sunday Church Services weekly at hired church premises in Deptford, London. Attendance is currently not more than 12 people on any one Sunday. The Trust also provides English teaching and practical help, advice and counselling to non-English speaking Vietnamese people. These facilities are provided by a British couple, Mr and Mrs Dunbar, who speak Vietnamese and are self-employed.

Proposal

The trustees have decided more needs to be done to help non-English speaking elderly Vietnamese practically and a community worker should be recruited. Mr and Mrs Dunbar will investigate this.
