Objects: THE FOLLOWING OBJECTS ARE FOR THE PUBLIC BENEFIT IN THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF CONGO:1. TO ADVANCE EDUCATION BY BUILDING AN EDUCATION FACILITY FOR CHILDREN WHO WOULD NOT OTHERWISE BE ABLE TO AFFORD EDUCATION.2. on the floor, together we have agreed to sponsor 35 children allowing them to gain education. We will now focus on reconstructing the school so the children will have a safe environment to learn.
