Chair's Report – Nature

- The fruit trees in our orchard are doing well and the flowers in our wildflower meadow attracted a wide variety of beneficial insects, butterflies and bees plus a multitude of moths.
- The moths are surveyed monthly for us by a county moth expert and included the twig-like Buff Tip and the Eyed Hawkmoth.



Chair's Report - Facilities

- We have installed a shed and purchased a sturdy wheeled strimmer plus necessary PPE to keep the paths clear of vegetation in the summer months. We are grateful for funding for this project received from Huntingfield Parish Council.**
- We hope to secure grants to replace some of the aging picnic tables and benches. The orchard fencing will also need attention soon.**
- The underground installation of power cables replacing the present intrusive overhead ones is now expected to start early this summer.**

The Huntingfield Millennium Green Trustees and committee continue to manage the green to keep it in good condition for the enjoyment of parishioners and visitors. We are pleased that we have several new members of our committee and I thank them and our long serving trustees wholeheartedly for their valued help in our efforts to keep this valued village asset available to all. Other volunteers are always very welcome to join our team.

The newly planted fruit trees in our orchard are doing well and the flowers in our wildflower meadow give a colourful display in the summer. The various flower species themselves attracted in turn a wide variety of beneficial insects, butterflies and bees plus a multitude of moths which are surveyed monthly for us by a county moth expert. These included the large and attractive Convolvulus Hawkmoth and Clifden Nonpareil.

We have planned some exciting fundraising events for 2024 starting with our Plant Sale that will take place on 19th May. Race Night will also be held in the autumn and our brilliant 100 club will continue to raise much needed funds throughout the year. In addition we are celebrating our 25th Anniversary in 2025 so will be holding a celebration picnic/barbecue party on the green.

We have had our play equipment repaired with the help of funding from the Heveningham Hall Country Fair Trust for which we are very grateful. Plans are proceeding for the underground installation of power cables to replace the present intrusive overhead ones. We have also installed a shelter to provide protection from inclement weather and shade for Pétanque players and other visitors; the trustees are very grateful for a generous donation from the National Lottery Community Fund.

We are pleased that we have several new members of our committee and I thank them wholeheartedly for their valued help in our efforts to keep this valued village asset available to all. Other volunteers are always very welcome to join our team.

Our amazing aerial runway is now up and running and proving very popular, many thanks to the Heveningham Hall Estates for funding and the local children for suggesting this brilliant addition to our facilities.

The newly planted fruit trees in our orchard are doing well and the flowers in our wildflower meadow despite the dry summer fared well and again included Pyramidal Orchids.

These varied flower species themselves attracted a wide variety of beneficial insects, butterflies and bees plus a multitude of moths which are surveyed monthly for us by a county moth expert.

We have held three fundraising events during the year, a tabletop sale, Apple Day and a "Horse Race" evening.

Our annual play equipment survey revealed that repairs are required on various items and we are very grateful to the Heveningham Hall Country Fair Trust who have kindly granted us funds to carry out this work.

Plans are still going ahead for the underground installation of power cables to replace the present intrusive overhead ones.

We intend to hold a plant swop event and also to install a shelter to provide protection from inclement weather and shade in summer for visitors, pétanque players etc.



The trustees continue to strive to maintain the green in a suitable condition for the recreational use of parishioners and visitors.

Exciting news recently has been that thanks to a very generous grant from Lois Hunt of Heveningham Hall Estates, we are planning to install an aerial runway (Zip wire).

The local children were asked to suggest an addition to the MG and this piece of equipment was the winner.

The playground company Playdale are supplying and installing this hopefully starting at the end of May.

A Giant Redwood was planted in memory of Esther Munns, a long serving trustee and well-loved resident of Huntingfield.

We have also planted several replacement fruit trees as some of the original plants are not growing well.

As part of the Wilderness Reserves nearby works, and at their expense, the unsightly overhead cables across the MG are to be replaced later this year with underground versions.

Due to various reasons e.g., moving out of the area etc. our number of trustees is a little low, but we have gratefully had some volunteers to fill these places, anyone else who would be happy to join us in keeping the green looking good would also be more than welcome.

We are planning some events and exciting additions to the green.

Shortly before the start of this period the the UK went into a national lockdown due to the Covid 19 pandemic.

Whilst this had a detrimental effect on organised events the trustees still varied out routine maintenance.

This included cutting the grass on the playing field and the wildflower area, inspecting and repairing the play equipment and regular site checks. Replacement fruit trees were also planted.

Although no organised events took place until restrictions were lifted the MG was used regularly for local residents to exercise and family picnics.

In August as the lockdown eased a little a socially distanced village picnic took place with over thirty participants.

We continue to manage and maintain the MG as an important local outdoor resource, which have proven to be of great benefit nationally throughout this major international crisis.
