Freetown Fire Disaster

On 5 November 2021 a collision between a petrol fuel tanker and a lorry at a busy junction of Sierra Leone's capital, Freetown, resulted in an explosion and a fire that caused 154 deaths and 304 injuries, overwhelming the city's medical services. New Life Kingdom provided funds for the purchase medicines that were donated to the Military Hospital and Connaught Hospital where most of the victims were admitted for treatment.

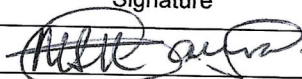
