To promote for the benefit of the public the conservation, protection and maintenance of heritage buildings and their contents, gardens and historic landscapes in the Czech Republic in particular, but without limitation, by supporting the Czech National Trust (CNT).

Activities

2024 was a successful and busy year for the Czech National Trust Abroad (CNTA) as we are nearing the completion of the restoration of our pilot project in the Czech Republic. We continue to help expand Czech National Trust's (CNT) international reach and educational prowess, especially by connecting much better on a practical level to the National Trust of England (NT) through educational trips to showcase and learn from the NT, as well as to the INTO (International National Trusts Organisation) through membership of the INTO Places programme. The continued help of our supporters enabled us to carry on with our work in support of CNT and Czech heritage.

1. CNTA/INTO arranged a successful working visit to the UK for a group of 12 Czech municipal and private château owners and managers, hosted by the NT of England, Wales and NI at Osterley Manor and Cliveden. Under the title "Learning from the best" the programme focused on volunteering, how to recruit, work with and retain volunteers, how to run a heritage property successfully and profitably by concentrating on introducing the parts of business which traditionally bring most revenue. CNTA prepared a rich programme for the group including participation at the AGM of the Historical Houses Association, where the group met HH's management to discuss individual approaches to maintaining historical properties.
2. CNTA hosted at the Czech Embassy in London a panel discussion and a presentation on the theme "Heritage! Stories of revival and resilience". Over 100 attendees heard how three different owners of historical properties brought them back to life through their sheer tenacity: Czech National Trust's pilot project in Moravia, two major châteaux in Czech Republic (CzR) which were returned to their aristocratic family owners in a perilous state after the communists rule ended, restored them beautifully to their former glory and an American filmmaker, who discovered that a family château in the UK needed resurrecting back to life. The evening was supported by Her Excellency the Czech Ambassador, CzechTourism, Budvar and INTO.
3. CNTA chairman Irena Edwards (as the INTO board member) represented the CNT/CNTA at the INTO biennial Congress "Facing the change" which took place in Amman, Jordan. The event was hosted by the Petra National Trust and its chairman Princess Dana Firas. Our chairman participated in workshops dealing with climate change and heritage, heritage in the war zones. All knowledge gained was conveyed to the CNT team in CzR and CNTA team in the UK.
4. CNTA raised £600 through its charitable activities and donated it towards the permanent exhibition in the Museum of Brno, Moravia of the architect Petr Franta's restoration project "Cairn of Peace" at the site of the battle of Austerlitz/Slavkov.
5. CNTA supported on its social media platforms a public fundraising campaign to complete the restoration of the Chinese pavilion in Kromeriz château (UNESCO) which CNT has supported for several years and which is nearing its completion.
6. CNTA helped out with manpower in the final stages of the restoration of its pilot project - classicist tomb and chapel of Maria von Ebner-Eschenbach, the famous Austro-Hungarian female writer, poet, philanthropist and philosopher, twice nominated for Nobel prize for literature (1909 and 1910).
7. CNTA produced the annual CNT/CNTA Newsletter - see <https://mailchi.mp/bb40923beae8/cnt-newsletter-2024-10333416>, and distributed it by email and on social media to subscribers in the UK, Czech Republic and many other countries.

To promote for the benefit of the public the conservation, protection and maintenance of heritage buildings and their contents, gardens and historic landscapes in the Czech Republic in particular, but without limitation, by supporting the Czech National Trust (CNT).

Activities

2023 was a successful and busy year for the Czech National Trust Abroad (CNTA). We continue to help expand Czech National Trust's (CNT) international reach and educational prowess, especially by connecting much better on a practical level to the National Trust of England through the Erasmus+ project, as well as to the INTO (International National Trusts Organisation) through membership of the INTO Places programme. The continued help of our supporters enabled us to carry on with our work in support of CNT and Czech heritage.

1. CNTA/INTO concluded in Prague and Libcice n/ Vltavou its support and participation at the two year international Erasmus+ project. The main focus of the project were staff exchanges between 6 European trusts caring for cultural heritage. CNT cooperated successfully in the Czech Republic with its partner ANOPA (Association of non-state monuments open to public). All CNTA trustees participated in the project and its successful outcome..
2. CNTA supported CNT and INTO in the development of a set of information tools (Toolkit) aimed at encouraging a wider range of visitors to historic sites. The toolkit is now available free of charge to the general public – see <https://www.into.org/broadening-access-toolkit/>. It consists of 12 case studies from SEECHT (Staff Exchanges in European Cultural Heritage Trusts) project participants.
3. CNTA supported CNT in hosting INTO Board meeting in Prague & Libcice n/ Vltavou. The INTO Board of Directors started their three-day stay in the Czech Republic as guests of the Czech National Trust and its chairman, Irena Edwards who is also an INTO board member and the Chairman of the CNTA. The annual INTO board meeting brought together all 12 representatives from many different parts of the world. The stay of the foreign guests in the Czech Republic was concluded by a visit to Karlova Koruna and Loučien castles at the invitation of ANOPA .
4. CNTA attended at the invitation of the British Ambassador, a garden party in Prague to mark the birthday of King Charles III and also participated at a working breakfast attended by CNT/NT experts on the topic of climate and its impact on historical monuments, organised by the British Embassy for Czech and international experts.
5. CNTA hosted at the Czech Embassy in London a presentation "Architecture of Memory and Test of War" followed by a panel discussion about the poignant new project of the Czech-Canadian architect Petr Franta and the challenges of bringing the Cairn of Peace, a historic memorial at site of the battle of Slavkov/ Austerlitz in CzR into the 21st century. Well attended event concluded with a reception celebrating 10th anniversary of CNT.
6. CNTA helped to secure further cooperation from a generous private industrialist donor which enabled CNT to substantially progress the internal restoration of its pilot project in Moravia and commenced work on the exterior. CNTA continues to support the project to transform the dilapidated greenhouse into a volunteer, educational and community centre. Its new eco-friendly and elegant design by architect Patrik Hoffman (Atelier Hoffman) will provide both facilities for cultural and other community events and a place to rest for our volunteers, local school children and visiting tourists

Objectives

To promote for the benefit of the public the conservation, protection and maintenance of heritage buildings and their contents, gardens and historic landscapes in the Czech Republic in particular, but without limitation, by supporting the Czech National Trust (CNT).

Activities

2022 was a successful and busy year for the Czech National Trust Abroad (CNTA). We helped to expand Czech National Trust's (CNT) internal and international reach and educational prowess, especially by connecting much better on a practical level to the National Trust of England through the Erasmus+ project, as well as to the INTO (International National Trusts Organisation) membership through the INTO Places programme. The continued help of our supporters enabled us to carry on with our work in support of CNT and Czech heritage.

1. CNTA/ INTO played a key part in the implementation of the Erasmus+ project in the Czech Republic. CNT coordinated an educational exchange programme between 5 European National Trusts (NT). The grant of 73,000 Euros continued to be administered by the CNT with CNTA/INTO's support from London. CNTA/INTO hosted the "kick off" meeting in Surrey, UK in June and the international exchanges/secondments of twelve heritage experts into six EU countries in the autumn. We helped formulate the programme of a fourteen-day secondment of two heritage experts from English and Scottish NT to the Czech Republic and two Czechs to the English NT and the Italian NT (FAI).
2. CNTA negotiated the selection of CNT as a part of INTO's global membership programme INTO Places and helped to launch it in the Czech Republic. The INTO Places programme allows CNT members/supporters to visit more than 1,100 historic sites in 31 countries (incl. Czech Republic) for free or at a significant discount.
3. CNTA supported CNT in the presentation of its successful project "Ticket to the New World" at the Bohemian National Hall in New York and two other venues. Programme included an exhibition, lectures and a book launch.
4. CNTA continues to support CNT's campaign to return the nationally revered monumental statue of the Winged Arrow by the famous Czech sculptor Otto Gutfreund, to its original location on the roof of the Skoda Palace in the centre of Prague.
5. We helped to secure a further donation from a generous private industrialist donor which enabled CNT to restore the front terrace of its pilot project in Moravia.
6. CNTA helped to forge a relationship with a new organisation of private chateau owners ANOPA leading to the signing of a Memorandum of co-operation. ANOPA represents 36 Czech privately owned and municipal chateaux. CNTA negotiated ANOPA's participation in CNT's Erasmus+ project.
7. CNTA continues to represent CNT on the Board of INTO.

The charity is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation with a constitution dated 25 July 2015 that was approved by all three trustees. The charity was entered onto the Register of Charities on 27 July 2015 by the Charity Commission of England and Wales.

Objectives

To promote for the benefit of the public the conservation, protection and maintenance of heritage buildings and their contents, gardens and historic landscapes in the Czech Republic in particular, but without limitation, by supporting the Czech National Trust.

Activities

2021 continued to prove a rather difficult year for our organisation due to the post Covid pandemic situation. Staging public events, getting speakers and attendees to travel to them (especially older ones, or internationally) to support our fundraising efforts were not back to normal. However, many of our friends and supporters continued to show us unprecedented support and friendship. It enabled us to carry on with our work in support of the Czech National Trust (CNT) and Czech heritage. Some of our work and meetings continued to be carried out virtually and through social media and our website.

1. CNTA supported CNT in preparation to present its successful project "Ticket to the New World" at the Bohemian National Hall in New York. Programme to include an exhibition, lectures and a book launch. The ongoing pandemic situation caused the event to be postponed, yet again to June 2022.
2. Together with INTO (International National Trusts Organisation) we continued to support a successful CNT application for an Erasmus grant to coordinate an educational exchange programme between 5 European National Trusts (NT). These are: INTO, NT of Scotland, FAI (NT of Italy), Herita (NT of Belgium) and Slovak NT. The grant of 73 000 Euros will be administered by the CNT with CNTA/INTO's support from London. The commencement of the project had to be postponed until 2022, however CNTA supported a series of strategic meetings online to revise the project plan and timelines in order to be ready for a "kick off" in early 2022.
3. CNTA helped CNT to launch a new campaign and continues to play a key role in CNT's efforts to return the monumental statue of the nationally revered Skoda Arrow by the famous Czech sculptor Otto Gutfreund, to its original location on the roof of the Skoda Palace in the centre of Prague. The statue was destroyed during the communist times and the CNT is endeavouring with CNTA's support to raise enough money to produce its replica and return it to its rightful place. The original drawings of the statue were gifted to the CNT thanks to CNTA efforts and were auctioned at the end of 2021 in a prominent auction room in Prague, and although unsold, it increased support from the media and the public for the cause, as well as increased donations to the project, to the CNT and CNTA. All will be used to further the project.
4. Governance

The charity is a Charitable Incorporated Organisation with a constitution dated 25 July 2015 that was approved by all three trustees. The charity was entered onto the Register of Charities on 27 July 2015 by the Charity Commission of England and Wales.

Objectives

To promote for the benefit of the public the conservation, protection and maintenance of heritage buildings and their contents, gardens and historic landscapes in the Czech Republic in particular, but without limitation, by supporting the Czech National Trust (CNT).

Activities

2020 was a difficult year for our organisation due to the Covid pandemic but also a remarkable one as so many of our friends and supporters have shown us unprecedented support and friendship. It enabled us to carry on with our work in support of the Czech National Trust and Czech heritage. Much of this work has been carried out virtually on Zoom, Skype, WhatsApp, by email and through Facebook and our website.

1. CNTA supported CNT in cooperation with the Czech Centre in New York in a successful webinar presenting CNT project: "Ticket to the New World".
2. Together with INTO (International National Trusts Organisation) we supported a successful CNT application for an Erasmus grant to coordinate an educational exchange programme between 5 European National Trusts (NT). These are: INTO, NT of Scotland, FAI (NT of Italy), Herita (NT of Belgium) and Slovak NT. The grant of 73 000 Euros will be administered by the CNT with CNTA/INTO's support from London. The commencement of the project had to be postponed until December 2021 due to the pandemic.
3. CNTA successfully applied to INTO for a small grant of £500 payable to CNT to support activities connected with Covid. This was used to produce a short animation film about Maria von Ebner Eschenbach, aimed to publicise CNT's restoration of the famous writer's tomb and chapel (CNT's pilot project) and to gain more public and community support of the project and our fundraising efforts.
4. CNTA played a key role in securing a gift of the original 1925 drawings of the monumental statue of nationally revered Skoda Arrow by the famous Czech sculptor Otto Gutfreund, which originally adorned the roof of the Skoda Palace in the centre of Prague. The statue was destroyed during the communist times and the CNT is endeavouring with CNTA support to raise enough money to produce a replica of this statue and return its original location. The drawings will be auctioned at the end of 2021 and money raised will be used to further the project.


