Objectives and activities

Summary of the objects of the charity set out in its governing document

The Object of the CIO is the advancement of health or the saving of lives for the public benefit. Specifically, the funding of scientific research into the prevention and treatment of strokes. (Constitution clause 3)

Summary of the main activities undertaken for the public benefit in relation to these objects (include within this section the statutory declaration that trustees have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission on public benefit)

While running the charity, the trustees have taken note of the requirements to operate for the public benefit. We note the Charity Commission guidance issued as PB1, PB2 and PB3. With reference to the reporting requirements in PB3, the purpose of the charity is declared in this TAR Section C (Box 1). We have reported on what the charity has done below. We declare that the Trustees, when making decisions, have taken due regard to the commission's public benefit guidance (PB1, PB2 and PB3) when exercising any powers or duties to which the guidance is relevant.

The charity has made a donation of £1,500.00 to The British Association of Stroke Physicians (BASP) and the National Institute for Health Research Clinical Research Network: Stroke (NIHR CRN: Stroke). These organisations invited applications from the stroke research community with the explicit aim of developing high quality research proposals intended for submission to NIHR Partner Organisations for funding. Successfully funded studies will then be eligible to be included in the portfolio and to receive NIHR CRN support with recruitment if they meet the criteria. Applications must clearly articulate and justify the proposed work to be undertaken. The Ian Foster Foundation provided £1,500 for a writing group shortlisted on merit by the BASP/NIHR CRN and then finally chosen by the Ian Foster Stroke Research Foundation. The money will be used to facilitate proposal generation via writing group meetings and associated activities of the writing group.

Section D

Achievements and performance

Summary of the main achievements of the charity during the year

Concerning the Writing Group support of £1,500, the support is for the chosen Writing Group "Adjunctive therapy in mechanical thrombectomy - PISTE Plus". Whilst the donation has been made to allow this work to begin, the Coronavirus pandemic has severely hampered progress. The original plan would have included publicity associated with the Joint World Stroke Organisation and European Stroke Organisation meeting in Vienna during May 2020. The publicity would have included NIHR CRN conducted trials that are being presented, as well as the commitment to new trials, through the writing groups including the one funded by the Ian Foster Stroke Research Foundation. Worldwide Coronavirus restrictions caused the May meeting in Vienna to be rescheduled to November 2020. As the Coronavirus battle progressed, the plans for the Writing Groups changed; the proposal was for initial virtual meetings with later face-to-face meetings as and when restrictions allowed. The media publicity has changed from Vienna to Helsinki in May 2021. It has subsequently been decided that the work of the Writing Group does not work effectively as an on-line virtual meeting. The work has now been deferred until face-to-face meetings are possible.

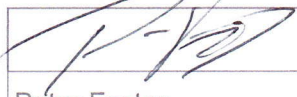
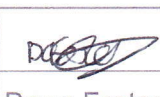
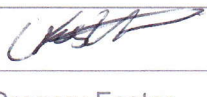
